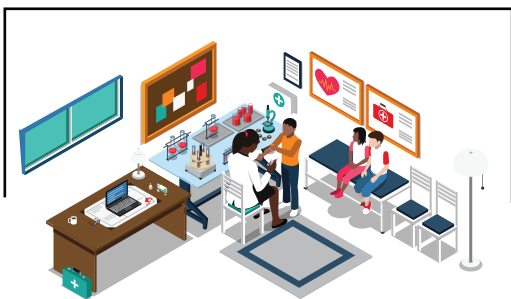




# SLPS Pop-Up Clinics to Provide Immunizations at **NO COST** to Families!



**Missouri law requires** that immunizations are updated before a child reports to school in the fall.
