WEEKLY COHORT MEETINGS

Our weekly cohort meetings give the program staff and fellows an opportunity to check in with each other and to continue growing our skills as community builders. In a cohort meeting, we might discuss: strategies for deepening conversation, how to follow up, campus resources for students who are struggling, or making room for self-care as students. So much of the fellows' work is about creating space for others, and this meeting time is about giving the fellows a space for mindfulness and reflection.
