22	enforcement of the State's criminal statutes in particular.

24	The Attorney General appears in this proceeding to protect the State's interests in public		
25	safety and the enforcement of its statutes. See ORS § 33.720(3).

2	The Attorney General requests that the Court declare that Initiative Measure 5-270,	
3	Initiative Measure 5-278, and Ordinance No. 2021-1 are invalid, because, inter alia, they conflic	
4	with and are incompatible with the State's criminal laws (including ORS §§ 166.170–.490), the	
5	duties of the Columbia County Sheriff, the duties of the Columbia County District Attorney, and	
6	the duties of other officers and departments of Columbia County. See ORS §§ 28.010, 33.720(3)	
7	4.	
8	The Attorney General also requests an award of costs, ORS § 33.720(5), and such other	
9	relief as the Court may determine is just and proper.
