Area Phi Beta Kappa (PBK) Association offers awards of \$1,000 to deserving recipients living in the Washington, D.C. area. Since 1974, this award has been made annually by our PBK Association to recognize outstanding local students and assist them with college or university tuition.

D.C. PBK will present an award of \$1,000 to **four** students who display interest in the liberal arts and sciences, love of learning, and civic responsibility.

Award Criteria

D.C. PBK will evaluate the following criteria in selecting our award recipients:

- 1. The student must be a high school senior with a grade point average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- 2. The student must show a commitment to the values and mission of Phi Beta Kappa, including academic achievement, community involvement, and a dedication to the liberal arts and sciences.
- 3. Upon selection, the student must provide a letter of acceptance from their chosen college or university.
