



Fall 2021 Scholarship Program High School Application







Application Deadline: Thursday, March 18, 2021

FALL 2021 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT APPLICATION PROCEDURES

All scholarship applicants must:

- Be a United States citizen attending a Prince George's County, Charles County, or District of Columbia high school; or reside in the DMV metropolitan area (within a 25 mile radius of the US Capitol, Washington, DC).
- Be a graduating high school senior (Spring 2021).
- Be planning to attend (as a full-time student) an accredited four (4) year institution of higher learning, an accredited Community College, or an accredited Trade School in the United States in the upcoming academic year (Fall 2021).
- Submit an official school transcript. The transcript must (1) include grades from the 9th to the 11th school years, (2) cite cumulative grade point average, (3) be signed by a school official, and (4) be stamped with the official school seal and sent in a sealed envelope. (SEE UPDATE PAGE)
- Submit one signed, dated (2020-2021 academic year), and typed letter of recommendation on the organization's official letterhead from a non-school related community service or job-related organization verifying his or her involvement. Letter cannot be from an immediate family member.

OR

Submit one signed, dated (2020-2021 academic year), and typed letter of recommendation on the organization's official letterhead from his or her current high school principal, counselor, advisor or teacher on the school's official letterhead.

- Submit a typed essay from 1 of the 3 writing prompts identified in this packet (maximum one page, 12-point font, double-spaced). Essay must be typed on a separate page.
- Submit a recent individual (decent) color photograph of the applicant. If selected, you will be required to sign a release.
- Be available to participate in the DNT Fitness Scholarship Awards Presentation to accept the scholarship award. Date and location (may be virtual) to be determined.
- Obtain your transcripts and other documents early. Only freshman, sophomore, and junior year
 grades are considered for scholarships. There is no advantage to waiting until the deadline to
 submit. The deadline will NOT be extended.
- Applications <u>MUST</u> be signed by the student and parent or legal guardian.

Submit your <u>completed</u> application (in its original format-Do not alter or recreate) along with attachments, official transcript, and recommendations to:

UPDATE—FEBRUARY 22, 2021

Due to COVID-related circumstances, the DNT Foundation Scholarship Committee has the following updates to the 2021 Scholarship Application:

1. Digital Transcripts—

Option #1-We will accept official transcripts from Scribonline, directly. When placing your order, please provide our e-mail address DNTFitnessScholarship@gmail.com. Your digital transcript must be received by the application deadline of March 18, 2021. The e-mail must come directly from Scribonline and may not be forwarded from the student.

Option #2—We will accept informal transcripts from the Guidance Counselor, only. Please have the counselor to e-mail the transcript as an attachment to us at DNTFitnessScholarship@gmail.com. In the subject line, please include "Transcript for STUDENT'S NAME-SCHOOL NAME." The e-mail must come directly from the Guidance Counselor's school e-mail account and include contact information. E-mails from students or forwards will not_be accepted. Your digital transcript must be received by the application deadline of March 18, 2021.

2. **SAT/ACT**—This requirement has been eliminated from this year's program.

 CATEGORY #3—OPEN ENDED SCHOLARSHIP Must be a United States citizen and reside in the DMV metropolitan area (within a 25 mile radius of the US Capitol, Washington, DC). Must be graduating from a public, private, or parochial high school in the spring of 2021. Must be attending an accredited 4-year institution of higher learning. Public school students with a GPA of 3.7 or higher should apply under this category. 			
 CATEGORY #4—COMMUNITY COLLEGE/TRADE SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP Must be a United States citizen and reside in the DMV metropolitan area (within a 25 mile radius of the US Capitol, Washington, DC). Must be attending (as a full-time student) an accredited Community College or Trade School in the fall of 2021. 			
 CATEGORY #5—FOUNDER'S CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP Must have participated with DNT Fitness (as a paying client) for at least 1 year prior to this application period.
