After Hours at Liberty: Barks, Brews, and BBQ



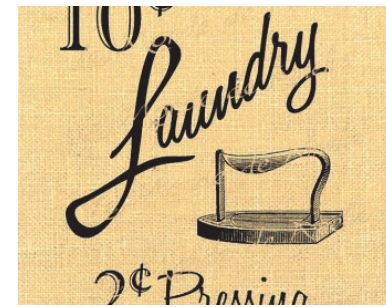
Bring your furry family and join us on the lawn of the Orlando Brown House for live music, food, and beer for purchase. Camp chairs and

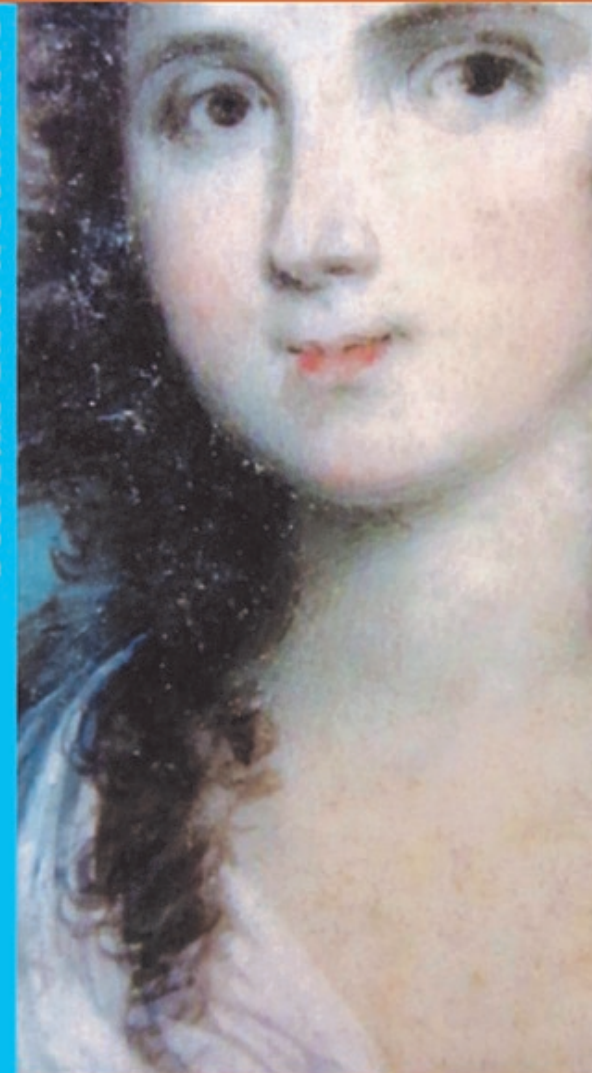
