For over ten years, OLV has been part of this world-wide society, which in the U.S. alone has 140,000 members. The Archdiocese of Washington has eight parishes with an SVdP group. Our currently seven Vincentians are dedicated to putting their faith into action through the service to the needy living in our parish or in other parts of DC. We do not just hand out money, for example, to those who face evictions or the cut-off of their electricity. Rather, we try to provide systemic help, by advising on balancing the budget, talking to the landlord or assisting with finding a job.
