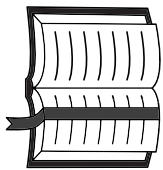
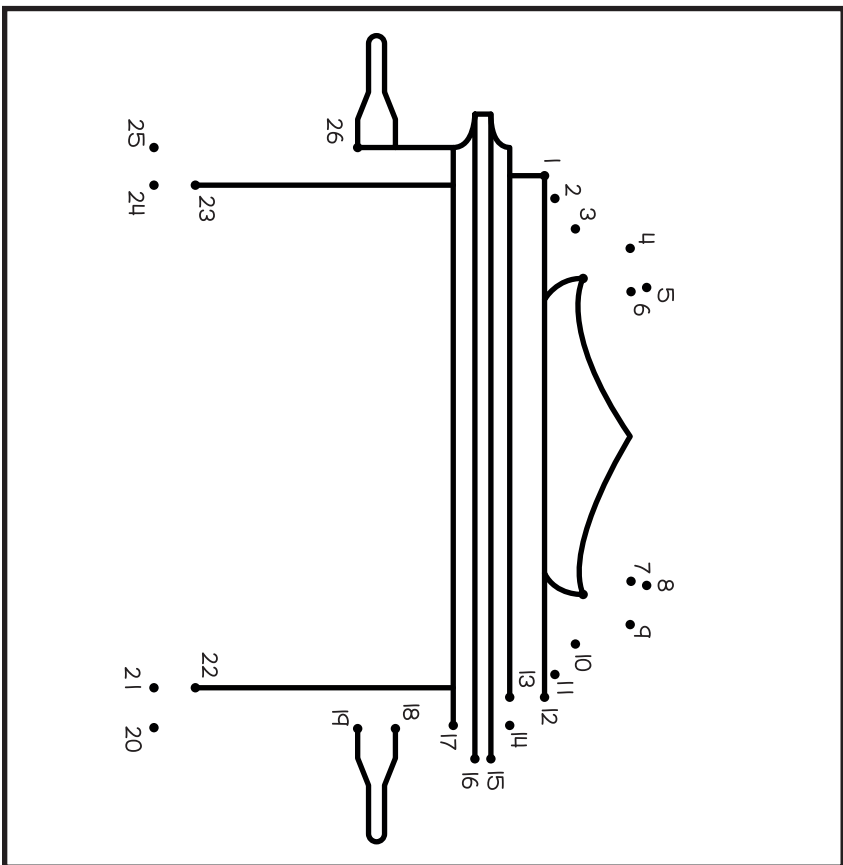


# CONNECT the DOTS

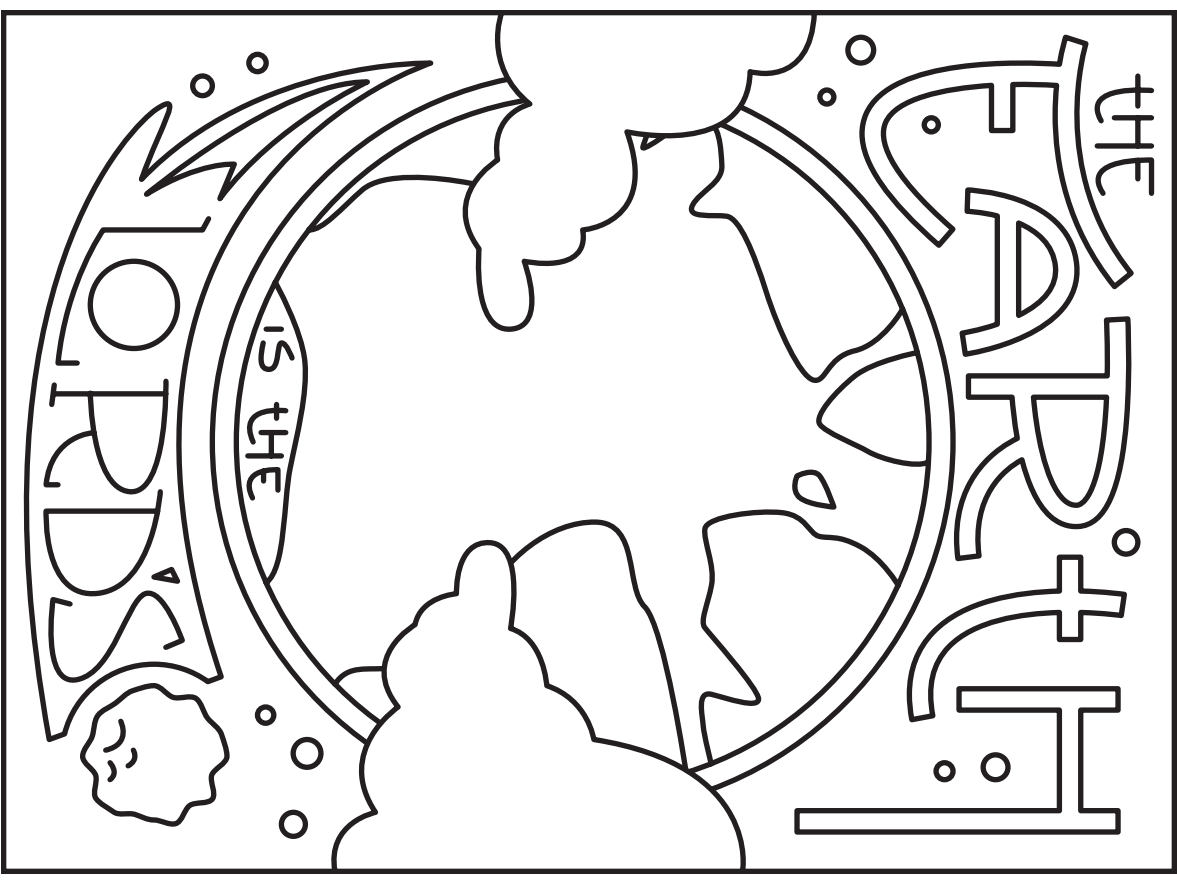

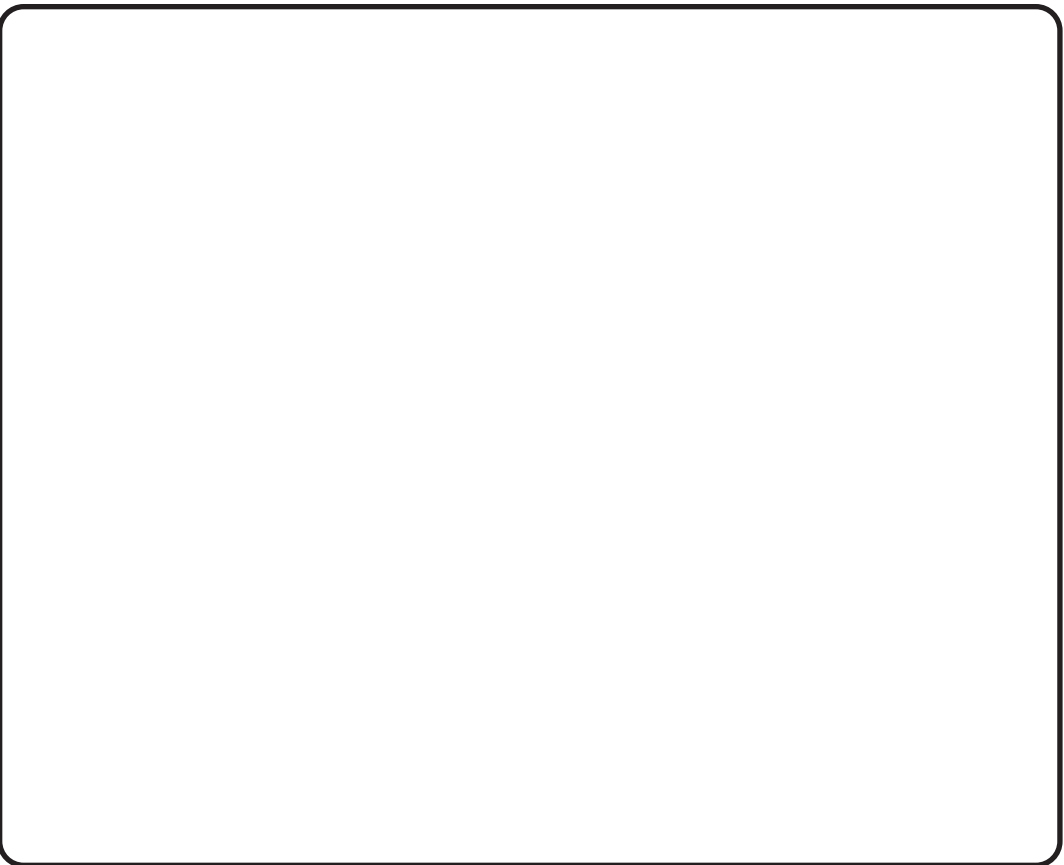
Activities based on 2 Samuel 6:1-5, 12-19; Psalm 24; Ephesians 1:3-14.





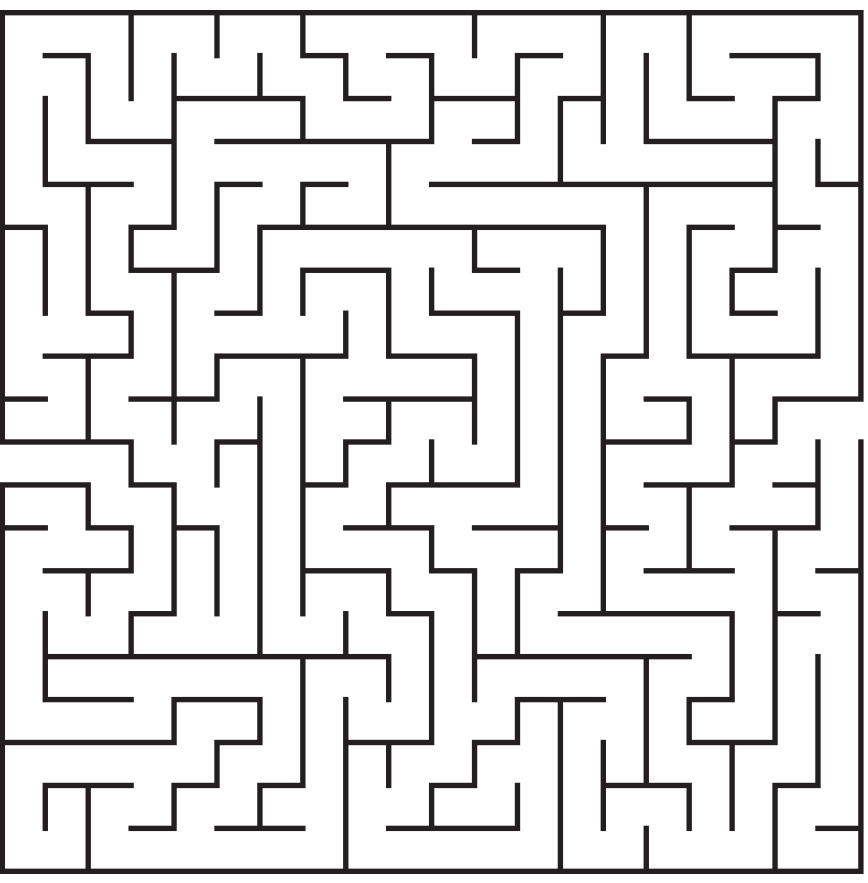
# DRAW IT
