Subject: Governance Nominations and Elections

Date: March 1, 2021

Governance nominations are now open through March 10, 2021 for students, faculty, staff, and administrators to serve as governance council members. Employees serve for two consecutive academic years, starting in August, 2021 and concluding in May, 2022. Students serve for one academic year, starting in August, 2021 and concluding in May, 2022. Employee terms are staggered, so only about half of the seats are available each year.

You may nominate yourself or others. If you are thinking about serving on a council, you are encouraged to have a conversation with your supervisor to discuss this opportunity for service and professional growth. You may need to consider how best to minimize disruption to your work responsibilities and to accommodate the time needed for governance, if elected. Although the work varies, a rough estimate of what to expect is four (4) hours a month for a council that meets once a month, and eight (8) hours for a council that meets twice a month. The time commitment for council officers is larger. Council members are expected to participate in training on Thursday of Fall Professional Week, currently scheduled for late August, 2022.

Nominations conclude on March 10, 2021. Elections are scheduled to begin on March 29, 2021. Between the nomination period and the election period, there is a time for employees to accept or decline any nominations.
