DEEP HOPE

As students return from break and/or launch into new courses, (re)introduce Deep Hope using a variety of activities over the course of a few lessons:

- Explore scriptures related to the key concepts of Deep Hope
- Design a hands-on activity for students to investigate part of Deep Hope
- Examine pieces of art related that relate to Deep Hope
- Do a word study or unpack the Deep Hope
- Read a story, poem, article, etc. that relates to the Deep Hope

Invite students to create a visual for Deep Hope, either collectively or individually. Include as artifacts on the Storyboard.



Use Howard Gardner's **Theory of Multiple Intelligences** to brainstorm and design rhythms and practices. For example, How could students activate musical intelligence to engage Deep Hope? What would it look like to incorporate kinesthetic engagement with Deep Hope?
