## **Modified Learning**

Our learning platforms have worked well during the first two weeks of modified instruction. We appreciate your ability to adjust to elementary packet pick-up and drop off and MS/HS Google classrooms.

- All assignments will be entered into the FACTS Family Portal for elementary and MS/HS classes.
- Our teachers are continuing to provide essential and relevant learning to ensure that we remain at or above state standards.
- Elementary students will be issued pass/fail grades for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. MS/HS students will earn letter grades for this spring semester.
- Elementary Families: Beginning April 15, each Wed and Thurs from 9 AM 3 PM we will be providing either hallway OR "curbside" packet pickup and completed schoolwork drop off in our parking lot.
