The Institute for Applied Sustainability at SOU is launching the Community Resilience and Leadership (CRL) Student Fellows Program, a new, year-long cohort-based experience for students who want to turn learning into action and make a meaningful impact in our region.

Built using SOU's living laboratory and our region, CRL brings students, faculty, staff, and community partners together to work on real-world projects that are co-created and co-led with community partners. Fellows develop self-and project leadership, systems thinking, and practical skills while engaging directly with the challenges and opportunities facing our region.
