REAL IMPACTS OF BIDEN'S FAILED BORDER POLICIES



In just one year, the federal government released 107,000 unaccompanied alien children to sponsors – the highest number ever.

Approximately 75 percent of the unaccompanied alien children encountered at the border during the 2021 Fiscal Year were purported ages 15 to 17, with roughly two-thirds of them being males.

According to a recent report, between January and May of last year, federal contractors responsible for placing unaccompanied children with sponsors across the United States were unable to reach the minor or the sponsor in roughly one of every three attempts.





In Fiscal Year 2021, Customs and Border Patrol Agents seized 1,000 pounds of fentanyl at the border, which is enough to kill 226 million people, or nearly 70 percent of the United States.

Today's border crisis is fueling the activity of drug cartels across our country. In 2021, fentanyl was the leading cause of death for Americans between 18 and 45.

In Fiscal Year 2021, the Department of Homeland Security reported a 35% increase in human trafficking arrests compared to the prior year.
