FEATURED ITINERARY Kaieteur Hiking Adventure

This 3-day adventure will have you taking river boats, 4x4's and ultimately have you hiking up from the Potaro River gorge to arrive at the splendor of Kaieteur Falls—with plenty of fascinating stops along the way.



Day 1 Georgetown to Mahdia

A one-hour domestic flight from Eugene F. Correia International Airport will take you over hundreds of miles of tropical rainforest to the mining town of Mahdia. From the airstrip, you will be transferred to your hotel via a short 4X4 drive to check-in, after which you will enjoy a lunch of local cuisine at a nearby restaurant. After, you'll go sightseeing via a 4X4 vehicle to several places of interest including the Denham Bridge (Princeville village, Garraway Stream, Tumatumari). Overnight at Roger Hinds Hotel. Lunch, dinner.



Day 2 Amatuk to Waratuk to Tukeit

After breakfast, you'll travel by boat for approximately 2 1/2 hours to Amatuk. Here, on this beautiful island of white sand, you will enjoy a delicious local meal, with the 52-metre (170 feet) high Amatuk falls just a few yards away. After lunch, your adventure continues with a quick 30-minute trek to re-join a boat above the falls for a short boat-ride through the rapids. You'll arrive at Waratuk, where you will portage the boat and trek into the pristine jungle for an hour towards Devil's Falls, and a refreshing afternoon wade. You will then set off either on foot for a 90-minute hike, or a 1-hour boat ride to Tukiet, the bottom of Kaieteur Falls. The simple Tukiet Guesthouse and overnight stop, provides the opportunity to take a refreshing swim in the Potaro River and a spectacular view of the gorge. Overnight at Tukiet Guesthouse in hammock/bed.

Day 3 Tukeit to Kaieteur Falls

You'll rise early to ascend the mountain from Tukeit to the top of Kaieteur Falls on a 3-4 hour hike. You will pass cool mountain streams where it is impossible to cross without a dip. The final and most challenging climb is known as the 'Oh my God' mountain. This climb will challenge you both physically and mentally. With your backpack strapped securely unto your back and your water bottle within easy reach, you begin your ascend. But on reaching the top, the struggle is forgotten as you catch your first glimpse of the mighty Kaieteur Falls, one of the world's largest and most powerful single-drop waterfalls. The Kaieteur National Park offers five (5) views and opportunities to spot the colourful Guianan Cock-of-the Rock and the tiny Golden Frog. After a tour around the park and lunch at the Welcome Centre, you will join a domestic aircraft to Georgetown. Breakfast, lunch.
