New paper is coming to Pendleton!

PENDLETON — Today's Journal will contain the very first edition of a newspaper covering the greater Pendleton area.

The inaugural edition of The Pendleton Post is inserted in today's Journal and will also be mailed separately to Pendleton residents.

As you'll read in today's edition, the Pendleton District once had the western-most newspaper when local printer John Miller started Miller's Weekly Messenger in 1807. Nearly 220 years later, The Pendleton Post is bringing a newspaper back to the area with a twice-monthly publication.

The Post will cover the town of Pendleton and its municipal offices; Anderson School District 4 meetings and Pendleton High School sports; and the area's events, history and community.

While you'll find feature stories about Pendleton athletics in The Post every second and fourth Saturday, results of each Friday's Pendleton High School football game will be published in Saturday editions of The Journal and will be available online at UpstateToday.com.
