

Summer Internships and Employment Opportunities

The Workforce Recruitment Program, WRP, is for students and recent graduates with disabilities and serves as a primary pipeline for bringing new talent into the federal government.

Eligible students must:

- *Have a disability and be eligible under the Schedule A Hiring Authority
- *Be a United States citizen
- *Be currently enrolled in a degree program on a substantially full-time basis OR
- *Graduated with a degree on or after April 1, 2019

Applying is an excellent way to:

- *Find an internship or permanent position at federal agencies
- *Explore careers in the federal service
- *Gain interviewing experience
- *Improve your resumé
- *Market your abilities to a wide variety of potential employers all over the United States

Applications remain active in the WRP database for one year (2022) to potential employers.
