





BRANCHING UP: VOCATIONAL CERTIFICATE IN URBAN GREENING & SUSTAINABLE LAND CARE

Are you interested in working in green industries, such as landscaping, agriculture, recycling, and waste reduction? Would you like a job with growth opportunities in an \$82 million industry? Do you want to earn a vocational certificate from Temple University?

Temple University's Branching Up program provides students with comprehensive skillsbased training that equips them for careers in green industries. The 6-week education program combines work experience in the Philadelphia Department of Prison's 200-tree orchard, greenhouses, hoop houses, compost facility, and outdoor landscaping classroom with classes on business skills, relationship skills, nutrition, and the fundamentals of organic agriculture and sustainability.

Students who complete the education program are eligible for 6-week paid internships with Temple University and others, where they'll continue to expand their landscaping and horticulture skills in a professional context.

classroom and hands- on experience



Hands-on experience includes:

- Working in a 200-tree orchard, plant nursery, landscaped gardens, and compost facility
- Cultivating, planting, harvesting, and maintaining fruits, vegetables, and flowers

Classroom sessions include:

- Communication styles
- Interview skills and practice
- Resume writing
- How to succeed in the workplace
- Effective teamwork
- Nutrition and shopping on a budget
- Fatherhood and relationship skills

Students must be comfortable:

- Working in all types of weather (heat, cold, rain, & snow)
- Working in direct sunlight for extended periods
- Performing physical labor, including walking, standing, and kneeling
- Lifting and carrying 30-50 pounds
- Bending, stooping, and twisting continuously throughout the day

Attendance is required at all sessions to successfully complete the program.
