The Virtual Campus: Empowering Students through Increased Online Education and Open Education Opportunities

Online education has been reshaping the academic landscape for many years. Montgomery College continues to expand its reach and improve access by offering more online credit and non-credit programs to students. In addition to the 37 fully online degrees and certificates, there are one fully online degree (psychology) and two fully online certificates (database systems and information technology) that are awaiting approval. There will also be a non-credit online certificate focusing on the workforce needs of the cannabis industry, scheduled to launch in Fall 2024.
