# **Ridgecrest Information**

As you enter Ridgecrest Conference Center, you will be greeted at the gatehouse and directed to registration in the lobby of Pritchell, a magnificent white building atop a knoll. Like many hotels, you'll register, receive your room assignment, and a map directing you to Laurel. Just steps away from this registration, LC2021 will have a check-in table. You'll receive your name tag and other important conference information. Volunteers will be present to help with luggage, too.

# COVID-19

While wearing a mask is encouraged in all areas, Ridgecrest requires a mask while waiting in line for meals and in all food service areas, largely the dining hall and coffee shop.

Room amenities include hair dryer, coffee maker, and a compact refrigerator. Each floor also offers a small room with a TV for your use.

#### **How to Dress Hints**

The average November high temperature is mid-50s to low 60s with lows in the mid to upper 30s. You will want to include a light jacket, and dressing with layers is recommended. Your walk between buildings is partially outdoors. While most of the walkway is covered, an umbrella may prove useful. Because there are no formal dinners or events, you can leave dressy shoes and clothes at home but include good walking shoes to enjoy the beautiful grounds.
