MOVE-IN

- Box cutter
- Trash bags

- Screwdriver

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- Backpack

- Flash drive
- Paper, pen, stapler, scissors, hole punch, etc.

STORAGE SOLUTIONS

- Clothes hangers
- Bulletin board + thumb tacks
- High Rise only: 3M command strips

*other halls will provide small nails and tacks on move-in day

FOOD

- Microwavable dishes
- Utensils
- Drinking cups, water bottle, snacks, drinks, etc.
- Chip clips and food storage containers
- Can opener

BEDROOM

- XL Twin comforter
- XL Twin sheets
- XL Twin mattress cover
- Pillow + pillow case
- Extra blanket
- Phone charger
- Fan
- Reading or floor lamp
- Light bulbs
- Candle warmer
- Candles (wicks must be cut so they cannot be lit)
- Iron + ironing board/steamer

BATHROOM

- Bath towels
- Hand towels
- Washcloths
- Toothbrush + toothbrush holder
- Tissues
- Hand soap
- Shampoo, soap, etc.
- Shower caddy
- Hair dryer
- First aid kit
- Prescriptions, OTC medicines, other health related items
- Bison Hall & Village only: toilet paper, shower curtain and rings

CLEANING

- Laundry detergent
- Dryer sheets
- Laundry bag/hamper
- Clorox wipes
- Disinfectant spray
- Windex
- Johnson Suite, Bison Hall or Village only: Toilet + shower cleaner

ESSENTIALS

- Debit card + check book
- Important medical records
- Financial aid forms
- Current insurance card
- Umbrella
- *Drivers license/passport/VISA
- *Social Security card

*will be needed for on-campus employment

ITEMS TO DISCUSS WITH YOUR ROOMMATE

- Area rug (Bison Hall & Village will have carpet in rooms)
- Curtains
- Smart TV with wi-fi capability
- Blu-ray/DVD player
- Video game console
- Message board for door
- Small vacuum and broom
- Cooking appliances approved for use: toasters (not toaster ovens)
- Coffee maker/keurig
- Mini fridge (no larger than 4.5 cubic feet and 34 inches high)
- Microwave

ITEMS YOU CANNOT BRING

- Unapproved materials for hanging items on walls
- Open coiled appliances
- Candles with wicks
- Incense
- Pets
- Alcohol, alcohol containers or alcohol paraphernalia
- Weapons
- Cooking appliances such as George Foreman grills, hot plates, open coiled items, etc.
- Tobacco and other tobacco-like products, including e-cigarettes, vapes
