- 30 Diploma Packet will be available via a drive through event from 11:00 to 2:00 p.m. at WHS main drop off loop**
 - Graduates or their parent/guardian pick up their diploma packet, that includes their diploma, final transcript, and immunization record on June 30th in the Main Office Loop.
 - Summer office hours for graduates or their parent/guardian to pick up diplomas, final transcripts, and immunization records are on July 7 or 14th in the WHS Ticket booth from 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m..
 - *Please mark your calendar to come to our drive through event to pick up the packet, as diplomas are often a piece of documentation needed in the graduate’s near future. Additionally, as diplomas are not reproducible, we want to be certain the diploma is safely in the graduate’s possession.*
 - **All credits must be officially verified and WHS fines, fees, and/or remaining obligations must be paid or cleared before the diploma, transcript and other documentation will be released.**

* Note that student fines must be paid, cleared, or arrangements made before students can: purchase event tickets (Prom, Commencement, Senior Breakfast, etc.) and/or a parking permit; pick up their graduation supplies and tickets, yearbook, and/or diploma packet; and participate in sports and/or the Commencement Ceremony. **Students with financial need are encouraged to contact their counselor throughout the school year.**

** Seniors needing a final transcript mailed to a post-secondary institution must make their final transcript request via completion of the Senior Survey & Scholarship Notification process outlined under April 1.
