Dr. Lacey is one of the PIs, along with Dr. Elena Martinez, of the California Teachers Study (CTS). His current work integrates epidemiology, informatics, and analytics. He spent 11 years in the NCI's intramural research program before joining City of Hope in 2009. As a PI he has received over \$28 Million in NIH grant funding for innovative team-based projects that have modernized all CTS biobanking and research activities. Today the CTS is one of the first cohorts to use the NCI's Cancer Research Data Commons Framework and make all its resources openly available to the entire community. He lives in Los Angeles with his wife and two teenage children.
