Requirements:

Word Count: 400-1000 words

The writing should be your original, previously unpublished work. Provide complete references for any quotations.

Articles should benefit teachers and/or administrators and should inspire or inform about new methods or helpful new products that you have used, resources, beneficial research, or ideas for helping students achieve the best results.

Provide your name, street address, phone number, and email address to the editor.

Submission is not a guarantee that your article will be published in a newsletter. Authors will be notified when an article is accepted for inclusion.

Nazarene Educators Worldwide cannot offer remuneration for your article if printed; however, appropriate attribution of the author will be cited.
