- Share the intended scope, timeline, and scale of the NITRO Program and how the proposers, in collaboration with the ARPA-H team and resources, can accomplish Program objectives.
- Encourage and facilitate teaming arrangements between potential proposers to achieve program goals.

Participation in this event is **not** a requirement for submission of an abstract, full proposal, or selection for funding. Additionally, all briefing information will be posted to www.SAM.gov after the event.

III. NITRO PROPOSERS' DAY INFORMATION

All times listed in this announcement and on the registration website are Eastern Daylight Time unless specifically indicated otherwise.

The agenda for the event is anticipated to include brief overview presentations by Government personnel; Lightning Talks by participants (1 slide, 3 minutes); and private sidebar meetings between the ARPA-H team and potential proposers.

This event is not open to the press.

A. Lightning Talks

Participants are invited to submit (1) PDF Lightning Talk slide/s that summarize their interests and capabilities (at the time of registration). Selected* proposers will have 3-minutes maximum to present their slide/s to the Government and all participants. Submitted lightning talks consisting of multiple slides or a single slide with multiple layers will not be granted a time slot if it appears clear the talk cannot be completed within 3 minutes. Only one lightning talk per organization will be allowed. Lightning talks from different departments within the same organization will be considered.

Interested attendees must identify their intention to present a Lightning Talk during registration by uploading the PDF slide.

*Lightning talk submissions will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, until the maximum possible number of submissions given the time constraint for the event is reached.

B. Teaming Profiles

ARPA-H believes teaming will be necessary to achieve the goals of the NITRO Program. To facilitate teaming, ARPA-H has created a Teaming page within its website. Interested parties are invited to complete a Teaming Profile via the link provided in the Registration form.

Once capacity has been reached, participants will be added to a waitlist. If slots become available due to cancellations, the slots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis from the waitlist.
