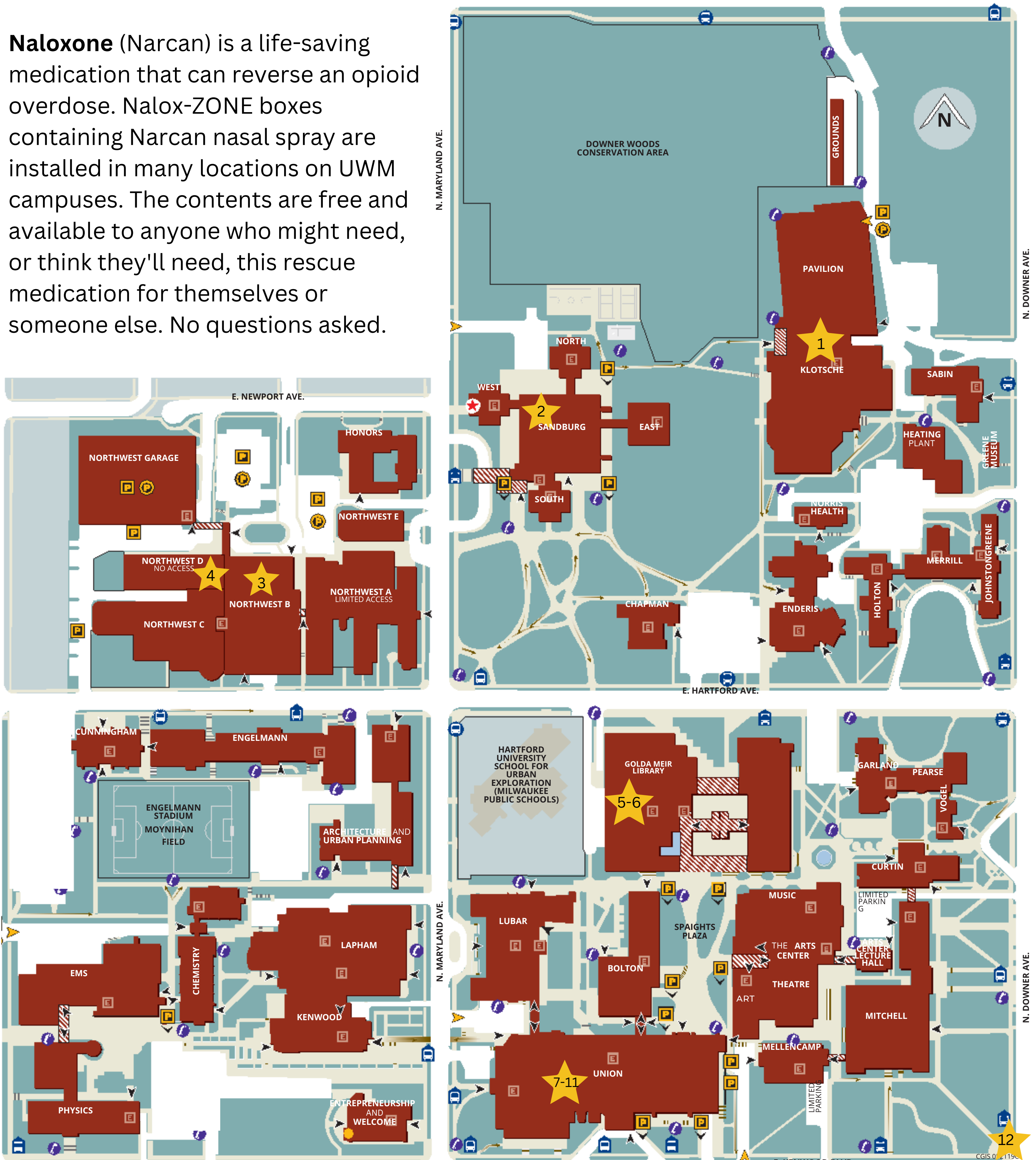


Narcan at UWM

Naloxone (Narcan) is a life-saving medication that can reverse an opioid overdose. Nalox-ZONE boxes containing Narcan nasal spray are installed in many locations on UWM campuses. The contents are free and available to anyone who might need, or think they'll need, this rescue medication for themselves or someone else. No questions asked.
