

Executive Summary of Changes for “GLI-33 V1.1, Standards for Event Wagering Systems” Public Comment Draft, Issued April 3, 2019

Below is an Executive Summary of the proposed changes in “GLI-33 V1.1, Standards for Event Wagering Systems” public comment draft:

- Reorganized and restructured document into more consumable chapters and sections, providing clearer distinction between technical requirements, which would be evaluated in the lab, compared to operational controls and procedures, which would be evaluated post system install, on-site.
- Added appendices pertaining to Operational Audits for Event Wagering Procedures and Practices, as well as Technical Security Controls to further help regulators and operators create more efficient and alternative processes to monitor wagering operations.
- Removed chapter for Self-Service Wagering Devices and provided pointer to the latest version of the GLI-20 standards, as the functionality of these devices are often incorporated with kiosks.
- Updated layout and formatting of the document to provide a modern feel to the standard.
- Updated Glossary of Key Terms.
- Removed Remote Wagering Devices chapter and incorporated sections of it into other sections of the standard pertaining to the System Server Requirements and the Wagering Device Requirements.
- Removed Player Account Requirements chapter and incorporated sections of it into other sections of the standard pertaining to System Server Requirements as well as the appendix for Operational Audit for Event Wagering Procedures and Practices.
- Transformed chapter for System Security Requirements into an appendix for Operational Audit for Technical Security Controls.
- Added various notes to improve clarity of requirements, and to better document known conditions or restrictions.
- Made various grammatical changes throughout the document to improve clarity and readability.
