CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

- Must be 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization or school
- Must be located within Eau Claire, City of Milwaukee, or Central Wisconsin (Wood, Portage, Marathon, or Lincoln counties)
- Must serve low income or underrepresented groups
- Site must be suitable for solar
- Commitment must be made by **Oct 15, 2019** with solar installation completed by **July 30, 2020**

- \$2,000 matching grant
- Unique Case Statement and assistance fundraising for remaining funding
