LRF and it's partenrs are off to a flying start in 2018. Led by GI Santa Margarita winner, Fault, and multiple stakes winner, My Boy Tate, LRF is poised to eclipse the \$2M mark in earnings yet again.

Team LRF recently ventured to the premire 2yo sale of the year, the Fasig-Tipton 2yo in training sale in Miami, FL and came home with two outstanding colts.

Hip 32, a Distorted Humor colt walked up and down consignor Eddie Woods' shedrow all week before LRF Executive Bloodstock Agent, Tom McCrocklin, approached Woods about the colt.

"He's being overlooked," said Woods. "This is my fastest horse and I screwed up his training. You must take a good look at him." McCrocklin obliged, fell in love with the colt, and LRF made the purchase. We named the colt SHANDLING, after the late comedian Garry Shandling, who had his own sense of distorted humor.

The uber-athletic colt breezed in 10.1 at the preview show (CLICK HERE TO WATCH BREEZE) and Equix' Suzanne Smallwood, an expert on stride analysis, called the breeze excellent. "Not only was he one of, if not the most efficient movers at the sale," Smallwood said, "we also measured his heart. His heart size is slightly above average but his he has athletic indicators that rate him an A+."

Shandling comes with an outstanding pedigree. By Distorted Humor, who has already sired more than 140 stakes winners and more G1 winners than all but two active North American stallions. Distorted Humor is the

only active sire with different winners of all three U.S. Triple Crown races, is the grandsire of a Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner. On the bottom side of the pedigree, Shandling is out of the very fast stakes winning daughter of Salt Lake, Salty Romance and is a half brother to G3 Cicada Stakes winner, Agave Kiss.

"I think what I like best about this colt is his speed and versatility," McCrocklin would go on to say. "He looks like the type that can run on anything - dirt or turf - and will be early. He's the kind of horse we like to buy because he's athletic and can win at six furlongs or longer distances as he gets older. Just a really nice colt!"

Shandling has already moved to McCrocklin's farm in Ocala, FL and is set to join the barn of leading trainer Phil D"Amato as early as June 1, with plenty of time to make an appearance at Del Mar this summer.

"I'm just stunned we got him," Phil said. "I loved his breeze and I think his speed will be very very dangerous as a two-year-old."

A 2yo son of a champion sire in Distorted Humor out of a stakes winning and stakes producing mare, we believe Shandling is a serious race horse with tons of potential. He certainly is no "laughing matter."

Distorted Humor has long been a source excellence and consistency that all began with Ky Derby winner Funny Cide from his first very crop. Now the sire of 18 G1SWs, Distorted Humor ranks as the #2 all-time sire of percentage of stakes-winners. Distorted Humor has sired winners of the world' best G1 races including the Ky Derby, Breeders' Cup Classic, Travers Stakes, Bemont Stakes, Whitney Handicap, etc.. On several occasions throughout his career, Distorted Humor sired 20 stakeswinners within the year and ranked among the top stallions annually. In 2018 Distorted Humor is once again represented by a top class 3YO in recent Tampa Bay Derby winner, Quip.

Shandling is out of the very fast and precocious Salt Lake mare Salty Romance. She broke her maiden 2nd time out as a 2YO by 4 1/2 lengths followed up with another wire-to-wire open lengths romp in the Delta Princess Stakes.

That speed and precociousness gene has now been passed down to her offspring as a producer of three black-type performers, but none more than impressive than very fast filly, GSW Agave Kiss. Winner of her first six starts by a combined 28 lengths Agave Kiss never trailed at any point of those races. The speed gene is one of the most heritable traits in a racehorse and when combined with a very successful stallion on top, the results could be very rewarding.

3. Inside information. We've been buying from and working with consigner Eddie Woods for the past 10 years. Woods, one of the best consignors of two-year-olds in the world, said after our purchase that "you will win a graded stake race wih this horse."

4. The McCrocklin Approval. When LRF Executive Bloodstock Agent Tom McCrocklin iikes a horse, we only do one thing... listen. McCrocklin was all over this athletic son of Distorted Humor and believes he is mature enough to go right on with him.
