# MUTINEER

LRF and its partners are off to a flying start in 2018. Led by GI Santa Margarita winner, Fault, and multiple stakes winner, My Boy Tate, LRF is poised to eclipse the \$2M mark in earnings yet again.

Team LRF recently ventured to the premiere 2yo sale of the year, the Fasig-Tipton 2yo in training sale in Miami, FL. and came home with two outstanding colts.

Hip 118, an Into Mischief colt made our short list the second he walked onto the track for the breeze show. He's light on his feet, like a cat, ready to pounce on his prey. Once we saw him for the physical inspection at the barn of consignor JJ Crupi, he went to the very top of our list of horses we "had to have". Please welcome to the LRF stable... MUTINEER.

The fast-twitch, well balanced colt breezed in 10.1 at the Fasig-Tipton preview show ([CLICK HERE TO WATCH BREEZE](#)) and Equix' Suzanne Smallwood, an expert on stride analysis, called the breeze one of the best in the sale. "He's the perfect mix of efficiency and quickness," Smallwood said, "His stride was within our range of top quality horses and I just love the way he moves so easily."

Mutineer hails from perhaps the hottest sire on the planet, Into Mischief. Into Mischief, who stands for \$100,000 at Spendthrift Farm in Kentucky, is the number one active Sire of 3-year-olds in 2018, led by Audible, winner of the GI Florida Derby and G2 Holy Bull Stakes, stakes winners Miss Sunset, Mia Mischief and Battle at Sea.

Into Mischief may be best known as the sire of multiple GI Breeders' Cup champion, Goldencents, as well as GI winner Practical Joke. On the bottom, Mutineer is out of the unraced Crafty Prospector mare, Fruhl's Gold. Every single one of her six foals are winners including \$100k earners Tie Dye and Wingate Hall.

"I've seen a lot of Into Mischiefs at the sales over the past three years," McCrocklin commented. "This is the kind of Into Mischief we want. He's not too big, but not small either and he's got tremendous balance and quickness. If I had to compare him to an NFL player, he'd be Odell Beckham Jr... and he has a little of his cockiness too."

Mutineer has already moved to McCrocklin's farm in Ocala, FL and is set to join the barn of leading trainer Phil D'Amato as early as June 1, with plenty of time to make an appearance at Del Mar this summer.

"I loved this colt's breeze," Phil said. "Into Mischief just throws runner after runner and this guy reminds me of Goldencents, who could just flat run!"

A 2yo son of the one of the hottest sires in the world, Into Mischief, out of a mare who has never thrown a horse that hasn't won, Mutineer is the type of colt that can take LRF partners on the journey of a lifetime.





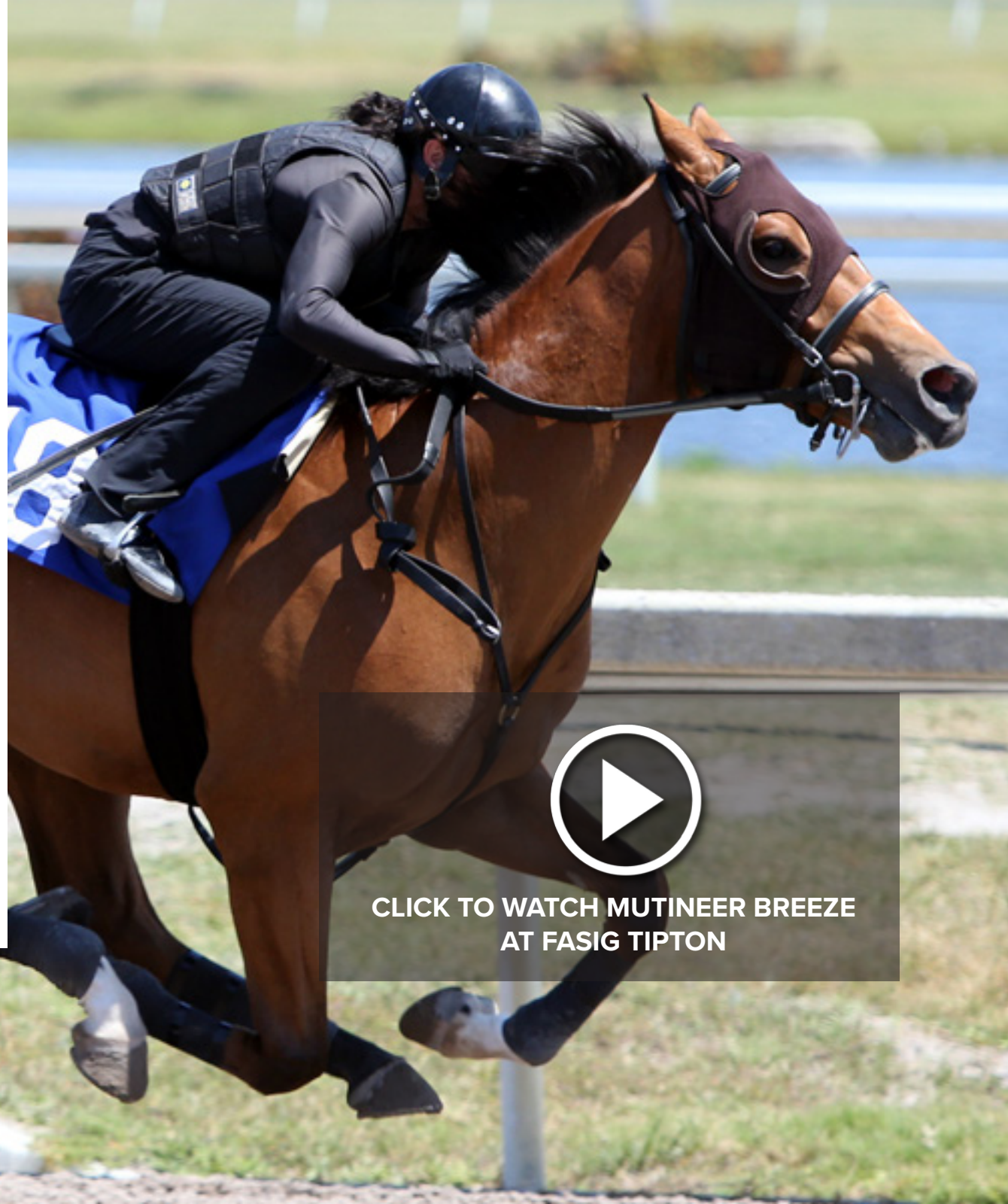

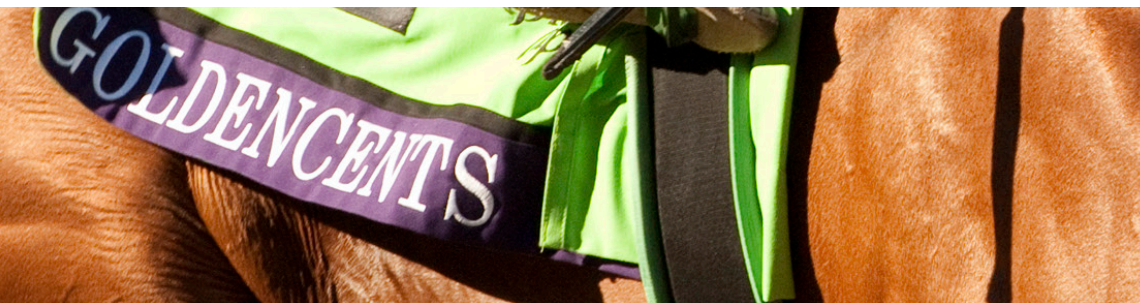


# FAMILY

From the start of his very first crop, Into Mischief has over achieved as a stallion and is now, regardless of age or stud fee, one of the very best stallions in the world. Starting off at a modest stud fee, Into Mischief has made his way on to the short of every prominent breeder in North America and now joins the ranks of leading sires and six-figure stud fee horse like Tapit, War Front, Medaglia D'Oro, Curlin, etc.

Into Mischief has proven to be a very versatile stallion that produces a wide variety type of horses at the top levels. He was a top sire of 2YOs in 2016 & 2017 and now holds the #2 position on the most current General Sires List. His 3YOs have recently become hot names on the KY Derby trail with horses like 2017 3X G1SW Practical Joke and one of this year's leading contenders, GI Florida Derby winner, Audible.

From a fantastic family that includes the very good stallion and MG1SW Street Boss, this pedigree is laced with multiple graded stakes horses and is still extremely active. Beyond The Blame figures to be very prominent in the 3YO filly ranks this summer and she also has a 2YO half-brother by Curlin that was a \$400K yearling purchase last year by Mike Repole. These types of pedigrees tend to continually produce Saturday afternoon horses and considering that some of Into Mischief's best horses hail from Mr. Prospector line mares, the foundation is there for a very exciting prospect.

2. His breeze. Mutineer looked as if he wasn't even hitting the ground during his 10.1 breeze at Fasig-Tipton. His cat like reflexes, balance and efficiency of stride should bode well when he hits the track as a two-year-old this summer.
3. Attitude. When looking at horses at a sale, the good ones have what we call "presence". Each time we inspected this colt, he came out with a grand presence and acted like a classy and talented individual.
4. The McCrocklin Approval. LRF Executive Bloodstock Agent Tom McCrocklin was enamored with this colt throughout the week and feels he may have been the biggest bargain of the sale. "With that pedigree and the way he moves," McCrocklin said, "he could be any kind!"
