WRIT OF ELECTION

WHEREAS, as of November 20, 2025, a vacancy exists in the representation of this State in the House of Representatives of the United States in the Eleventh Congressional District due to the resignation of the Honorable Mikie Sherrill; and

WHEREAS, under these circumstances, N.J.S.A. 19:3-27 and N.J.S.A. 19:27-4 require that a Writ of Election be issued by the Governor of the State of New Jersey, and under N.J.S.A. 19:27-6, the Writ may prescribe the dates for a special primary and general election for the purpose of filling such vacancy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PHILIP D. MURPHY, Governor of the State of New Jersey, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:3-27, N.J.S.A. 19:27-4 and N.J.S.A. 19:27-6, hereby issue this Writ of Election directing that a special general election be held to fill the unexpired term for the office of Member of the United States House of Representatives, Eleventh Congressional District on April 16, 2026. The nomination of political party candidates to fill such vacancy shall be made in the manner provided by law at a special primary election to be held on February 5, 2026. Nomination petitions shall be filed before 4:00 p.m. on December 1, 2025. Direct nominations by petition shall be filed no later than the day of the special primary election. The Secretary of State or her designee shall promptly adopt any guidelines necessary to effectuate this Writ of Election.
