WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to highlight the importance of our essential school bus transportation team, who provided food delivery to our students during our virtual year, and have now implemented new safety guidelines in order to protect the many students in their care; and

WHEREAS, the School Board of the City of Richmond, the school administration salute and appreciate school bus transportation employees and recognize the invaluable contributions they make to public education and student success;
