

MANDATORY HUMAN TRAFFICKING TRAINING

END SLAVERY TN

DEADLINE: MARCH 31, 2020

According to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, “human trafficking is the second-fastest growing criminal industry, just behind drug trafficking,” Director Jennifer Brinkman said. A new law signed by Gov. Bill Lee in April 2019 requires that public schools include information about human trafficking involving children – and requires teachers to receive special instruction.

Public Chapter 269 requires *that each certified employee receive a one-time in-service training on the detection, intervention, prevention, and treatment of human trafficking in which the victim is a child.*

Therefore, please sign up, enroll and complete the following MANDATORY training *before March 31, 2020*. When finished, please submit your certificate to your Executive Principal or school designee that will be collecting this information.

1. Go to the URL: https://courses.endslaverytn.org/users/sign_in
2. Go to the bottom of the page to “Create a New Account”
3. Go to the third (3rd) icon, “Introduction to Human Trafficking for Tennessee Educators” and click on it
4. Click on Enroll Now
5. Watch the Video/Take the Course (This will take 60-90 minutes to complete)
6. Once you have finished all modules, you will get a message that says, “To receive your **Certificate of Completion**, please complete the Post-Test that encompasses the core concepts presented in this course for the detection, intervention, prevention, and treatment for victims of human trafficking”.
 - **You MUST score an 80% or higher to Pass.**
 - At the end of the quiz it will state:

Good job!

You passed this quiz with a score of

100%

(You need 80% to pass, but can retake until you pass)

7. They will then ask you to complete a short survey to receive your feedback on the effectiveness of this training and opportunities to improve their online experiences. ***In order to receive your certificate, you MUST complete the survey.***
8. Once the survey is complete, it will state: “Congratulations on completing Human Trafficking For TN Educators from Margie's School! You can now share or download your certificate.

Margie's School has created a digital certificate available in an online format so that you can easily retrieve and share the details of your achievement (email it, pdf and download, Facebook, etc.).

***** Please ensure that you email, print or save your certificate, as you will need to turn it into your designated school official as proof of completion.***
