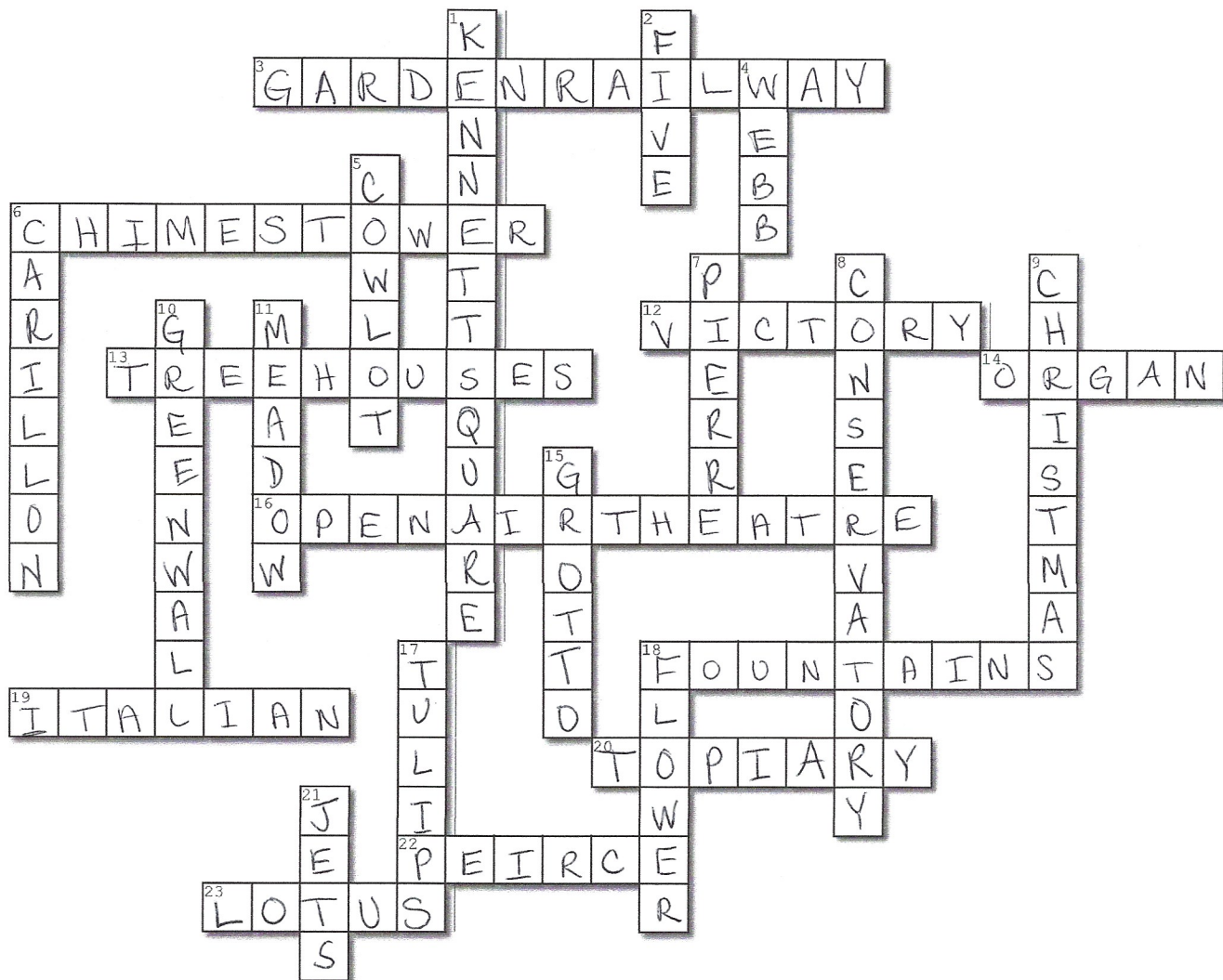


Longwood Crossword
