Why do young people need to vote?

Take a couple of minutes to talk
about this question.

✓ Young voters account for half of the voting population, making them a powerful political force

✓ Yet older Americans are more likely to vote

Politicians listen to people who vote

✓ Every vote counts

Elections have been determined by less than 100 votes.

✓ Young people were hit hardest by the great recession

✓ Young voters are an incredibly diverse group

✓ The youth vote can sway the election

✓ You may not care now, but you might in four years

Also....because it's a right and privilege....

- Voting rights have been hard won over the years with entrenched groups trying to keep the privilege only for themselves.
- It used to be only white male landowners who could vote.
- Those with power wanted to keep women, non-English-speaking folks, people of color and young people (the voting age used to be 21) from being able to vote.
- There was once a poll tax and you had to pay to vote in order to keep away those who couldn't afford it.
- In summary, it's taken hundreds of years and countless number of people and hours to gain this right for us! Cast your ballot and thank those that made it possible.



#FutureVoter

- 16 and 17 year olds can now pre-register to vote. Registrants under the age of 18 will have their registrations held until they become eligible to vote.
- Future Voter sign-up information is protected while underage. Once you turn 18 you become registered and voter registration information is public.

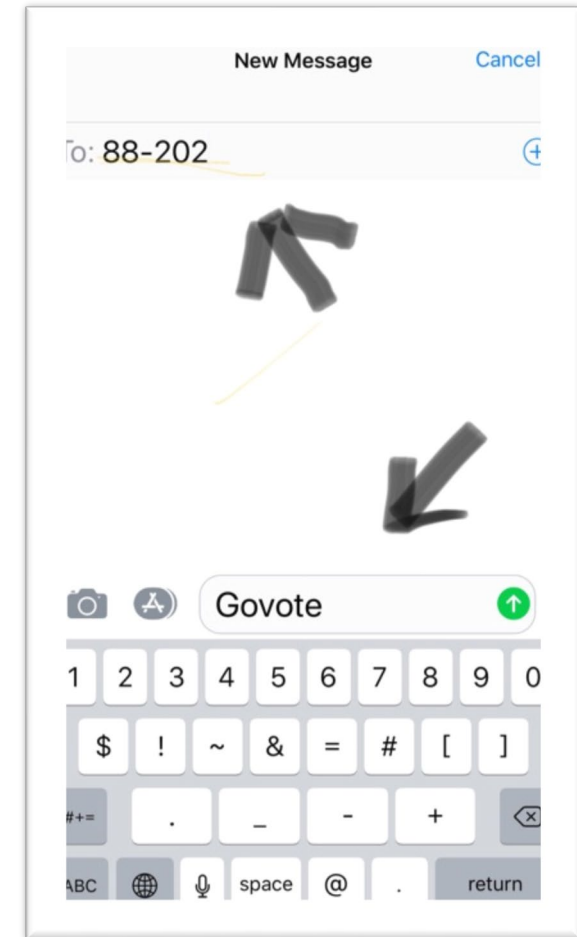

Want to sign up for text voter alerts?

Text Govote to 88-202 follow the prompts

- You will receive notices
 - When the ballot is in your mailbox
 - Reminders to vote
 - Reminders when the deadline is for returning your ballot

You can also just put the election dates in your online calendar.



Additional Details for New Voters Registering Online

- When you register online, use the name that is on your WA state license/permit/ID.
- When you vote, sign your name the same way you signed your license/permit/ID. The Elections Office checks for voter fraud by comparing your signatures.
- It is recommended that you provide your cell or email contact so the Elections Office can contact you if there are questions about your registration or ballot.
