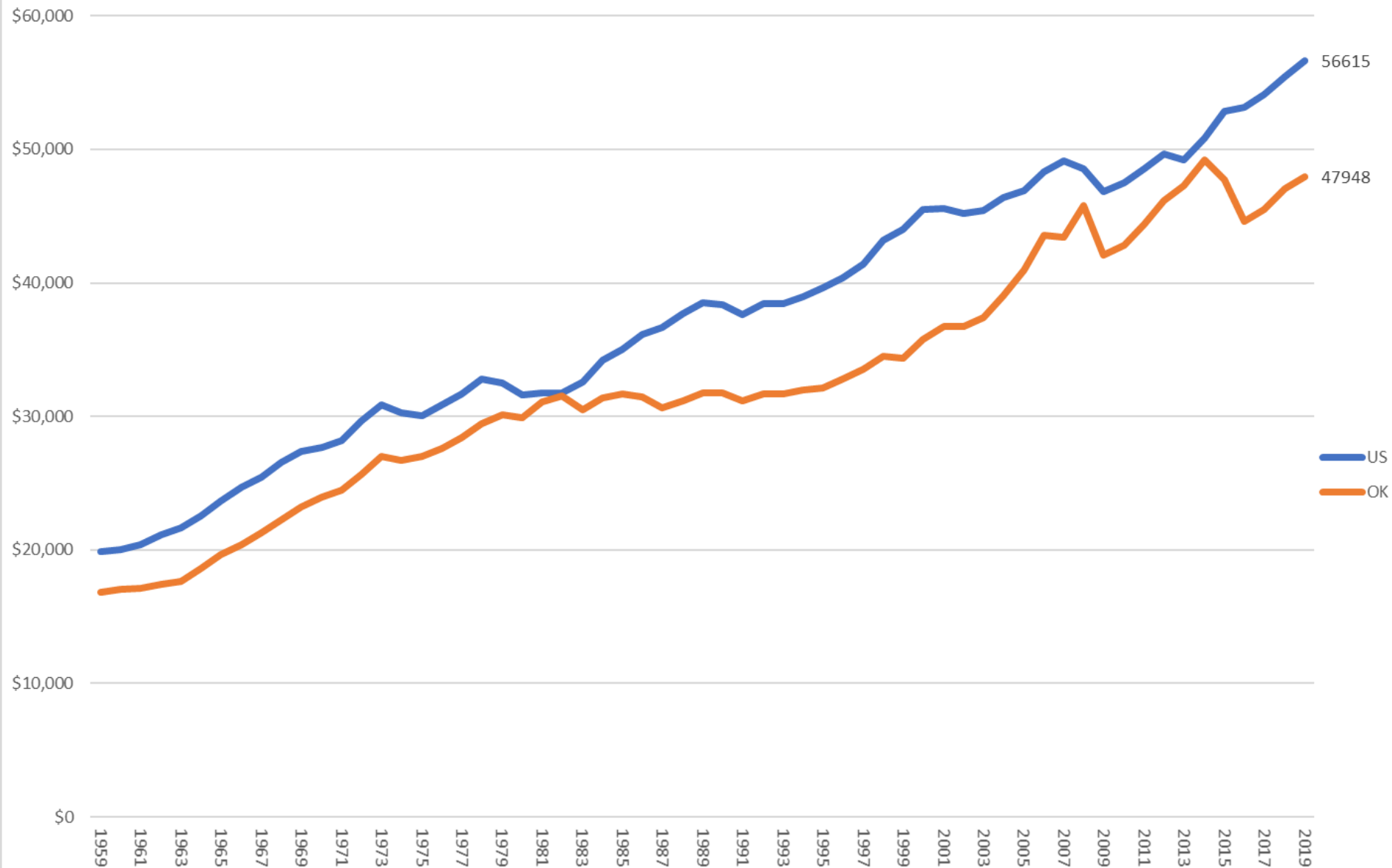

US and Oklahoma Real Per-Capita Personal Income: 1959 - 2019

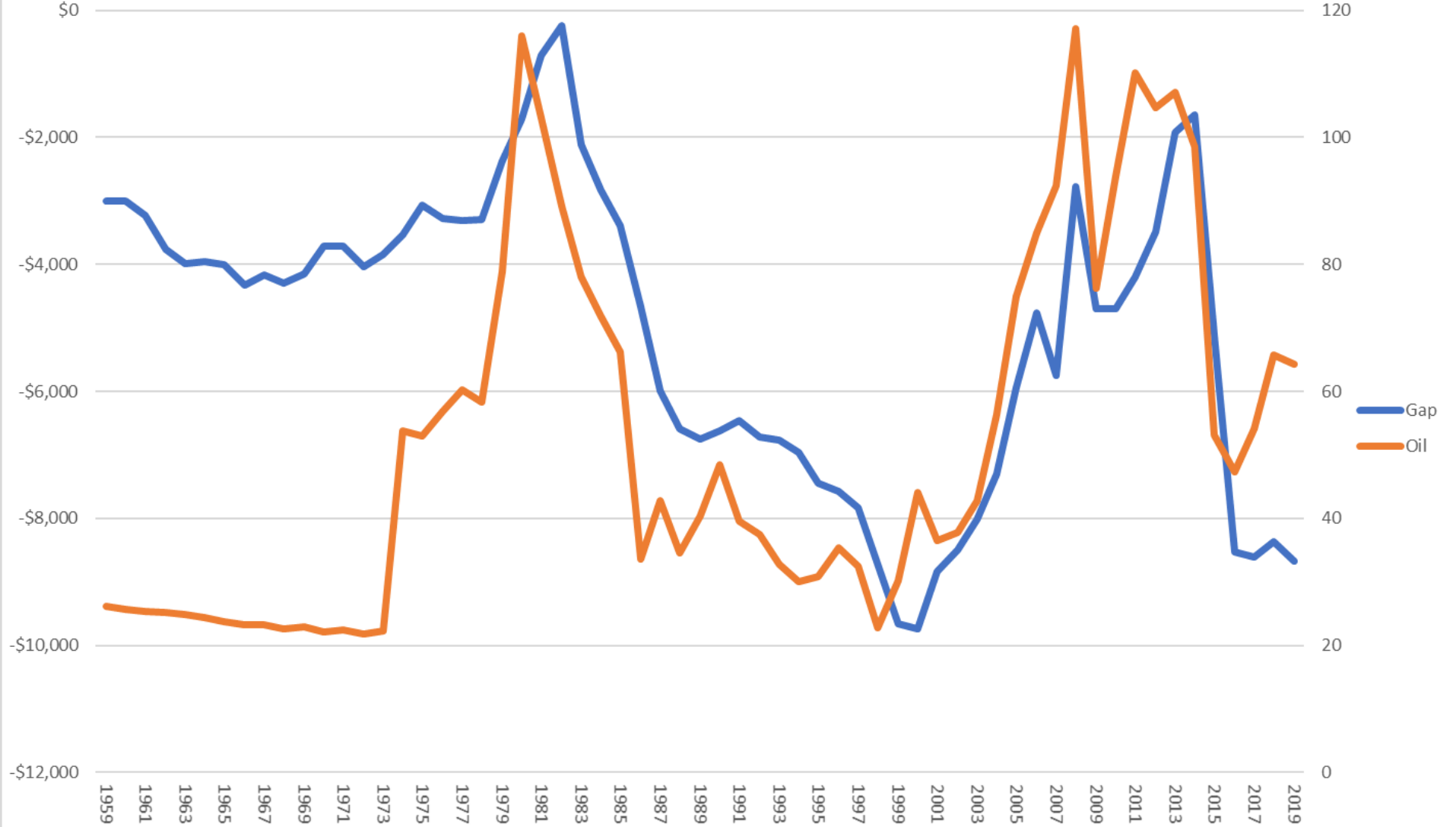

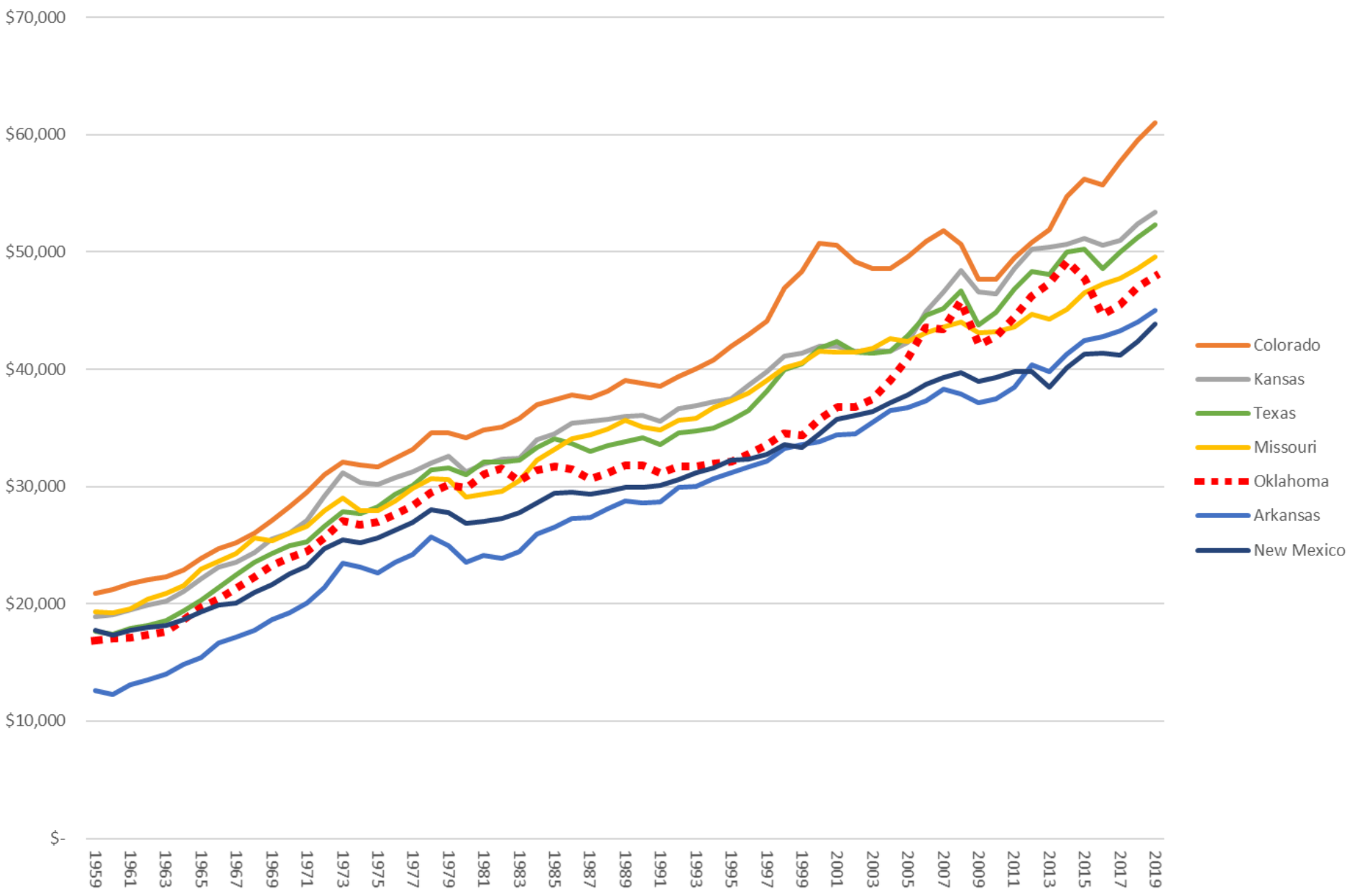

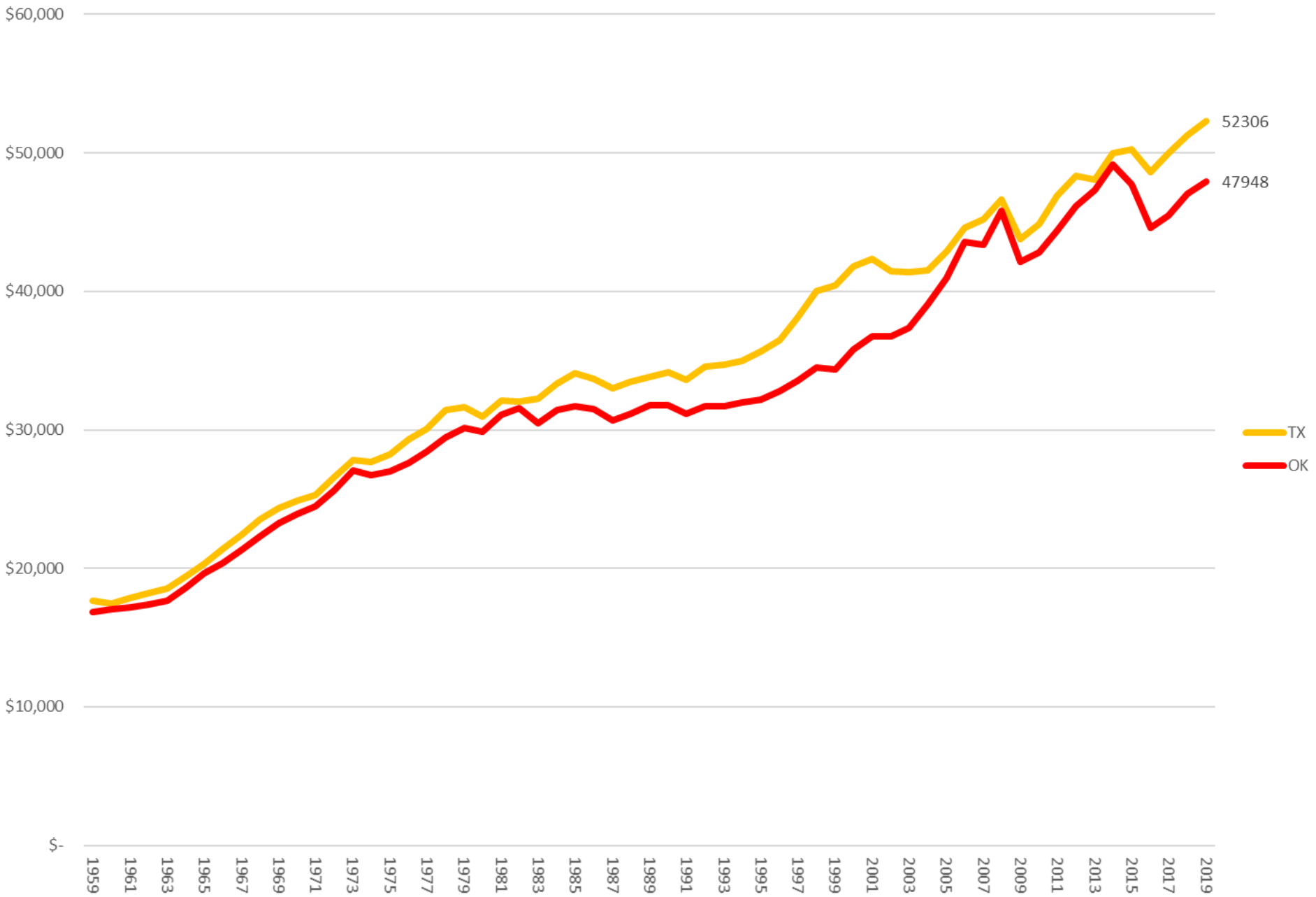

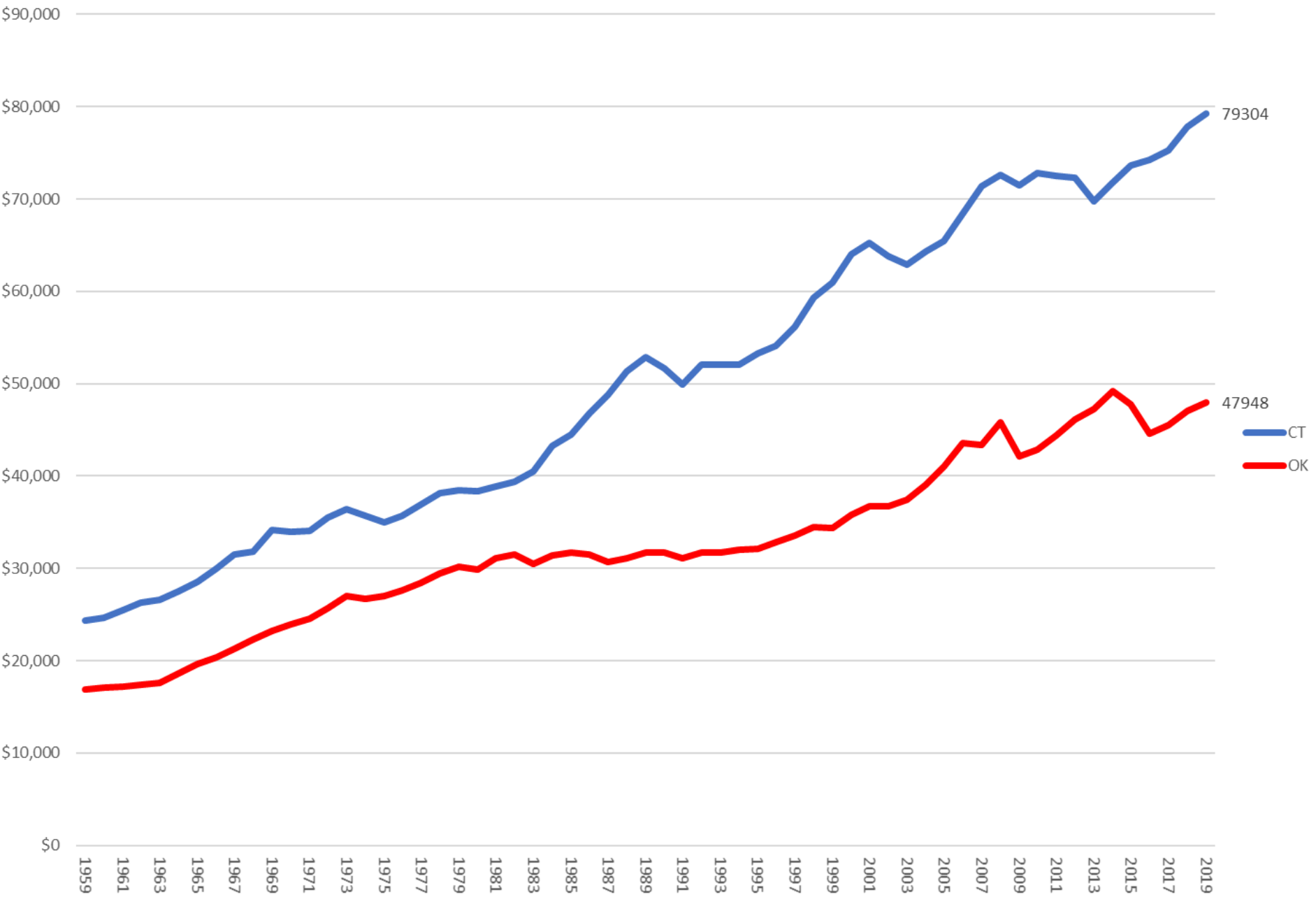
Real Per Capita Personal Income: Oklahoma and Contiguous States: 1959 - 2019



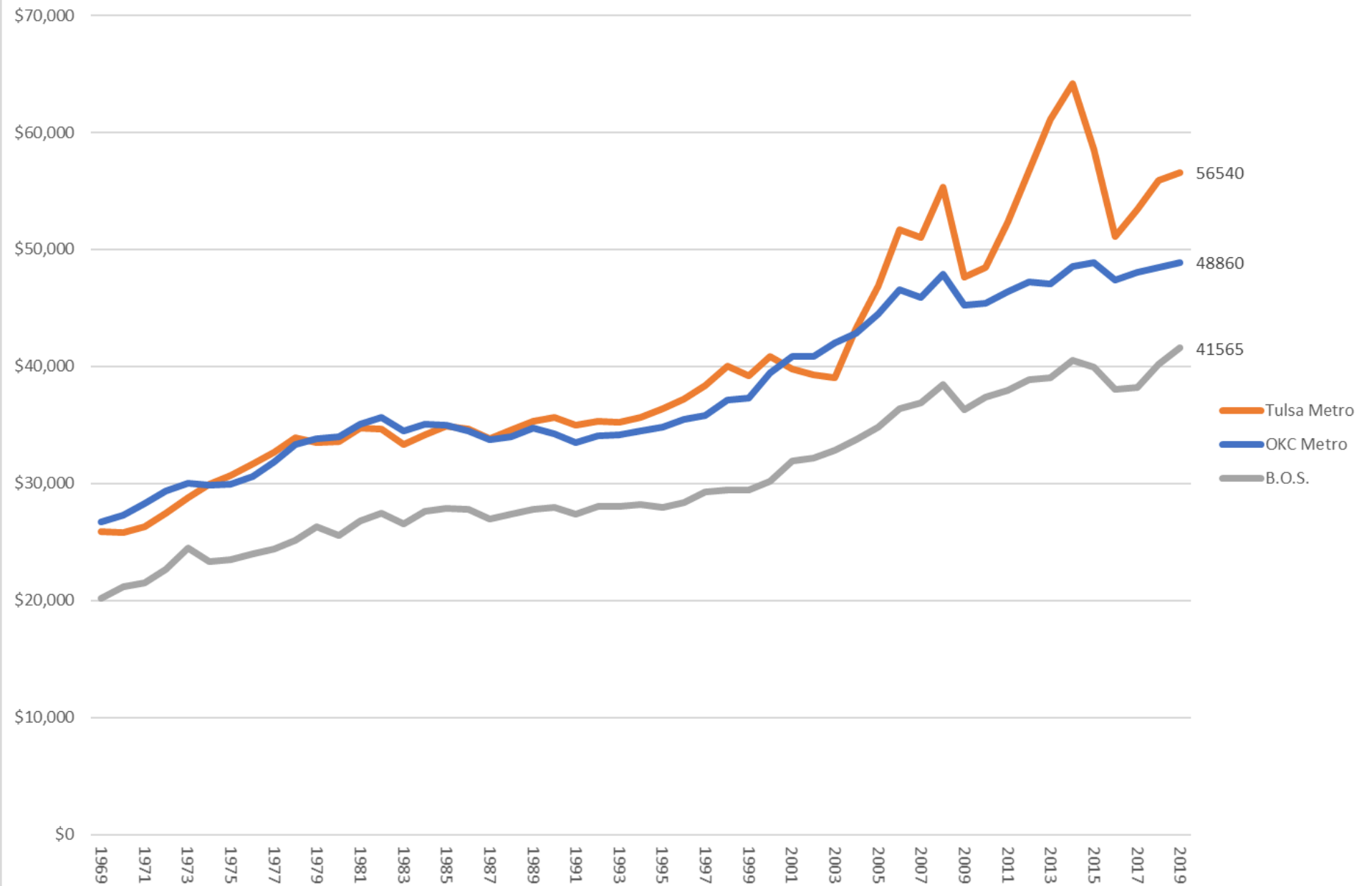
Real Per Capita Personal Income: Oklahoma v. Texas, 1959 - 2019



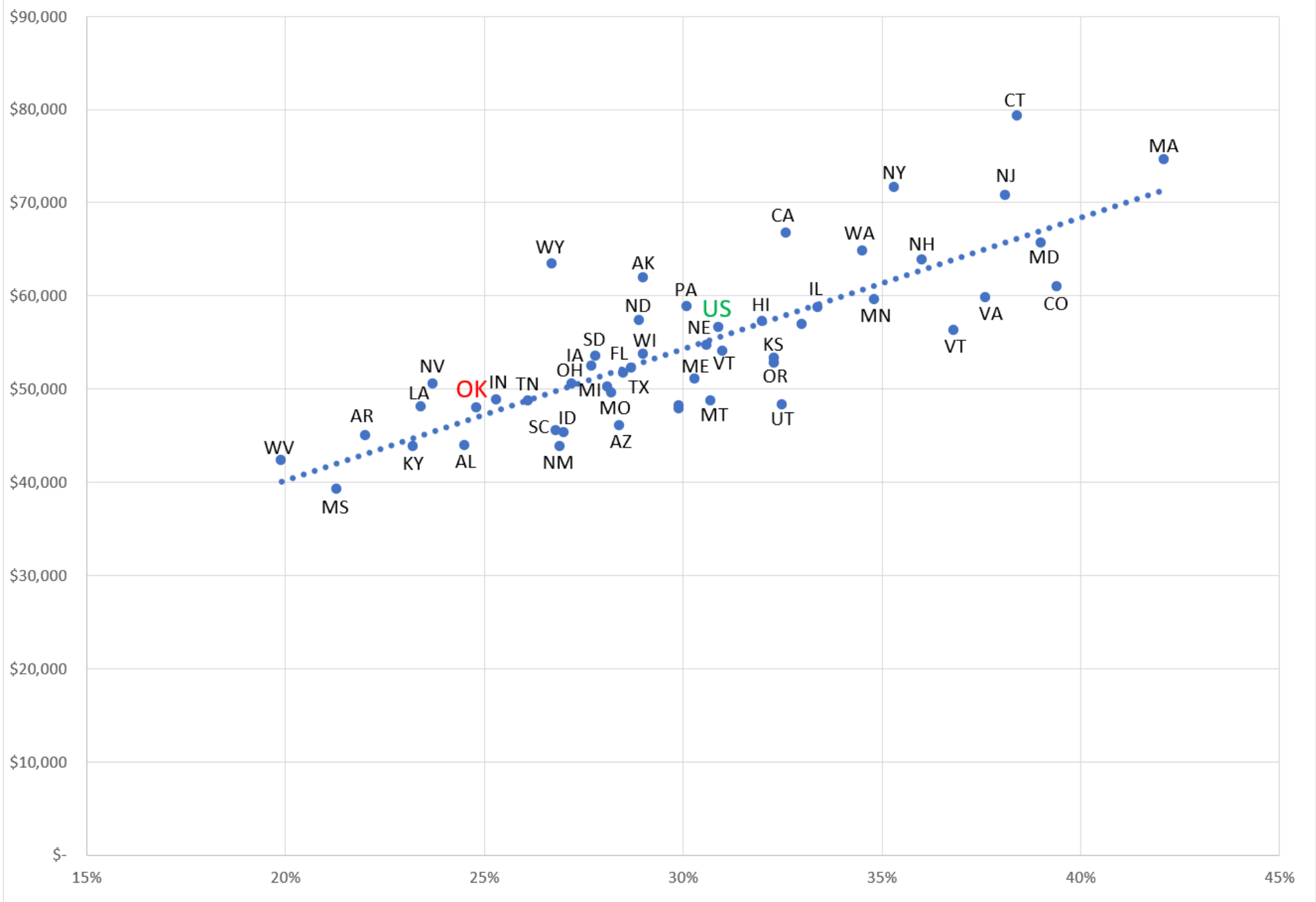
Real Per Capita Personal Income: Oklahoma v. Connecticut, 1959 - 2019



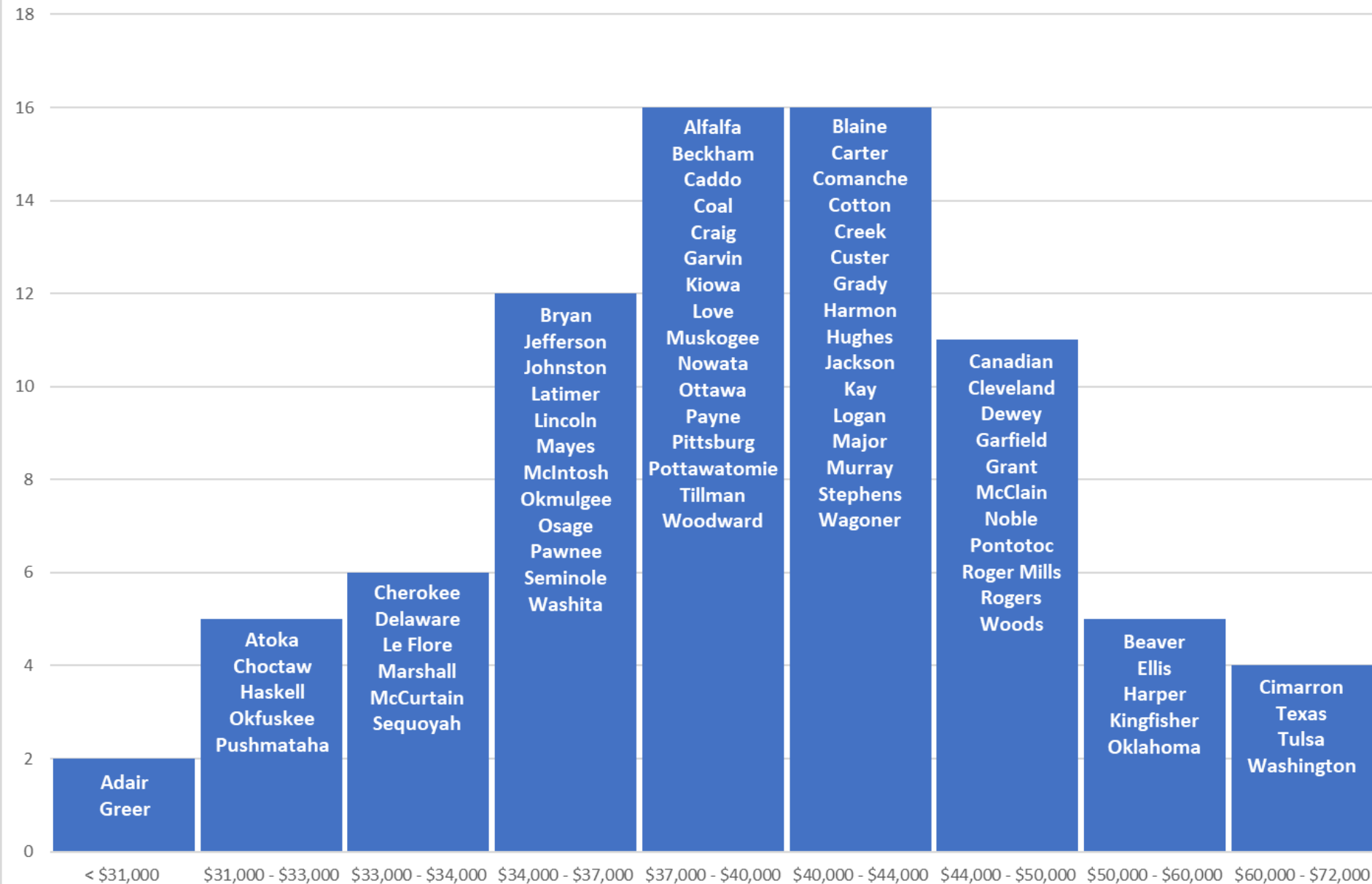
Real Per Capita Personal Income--OKC, TUL Metro Areas and Balance of State 1969 - 2019



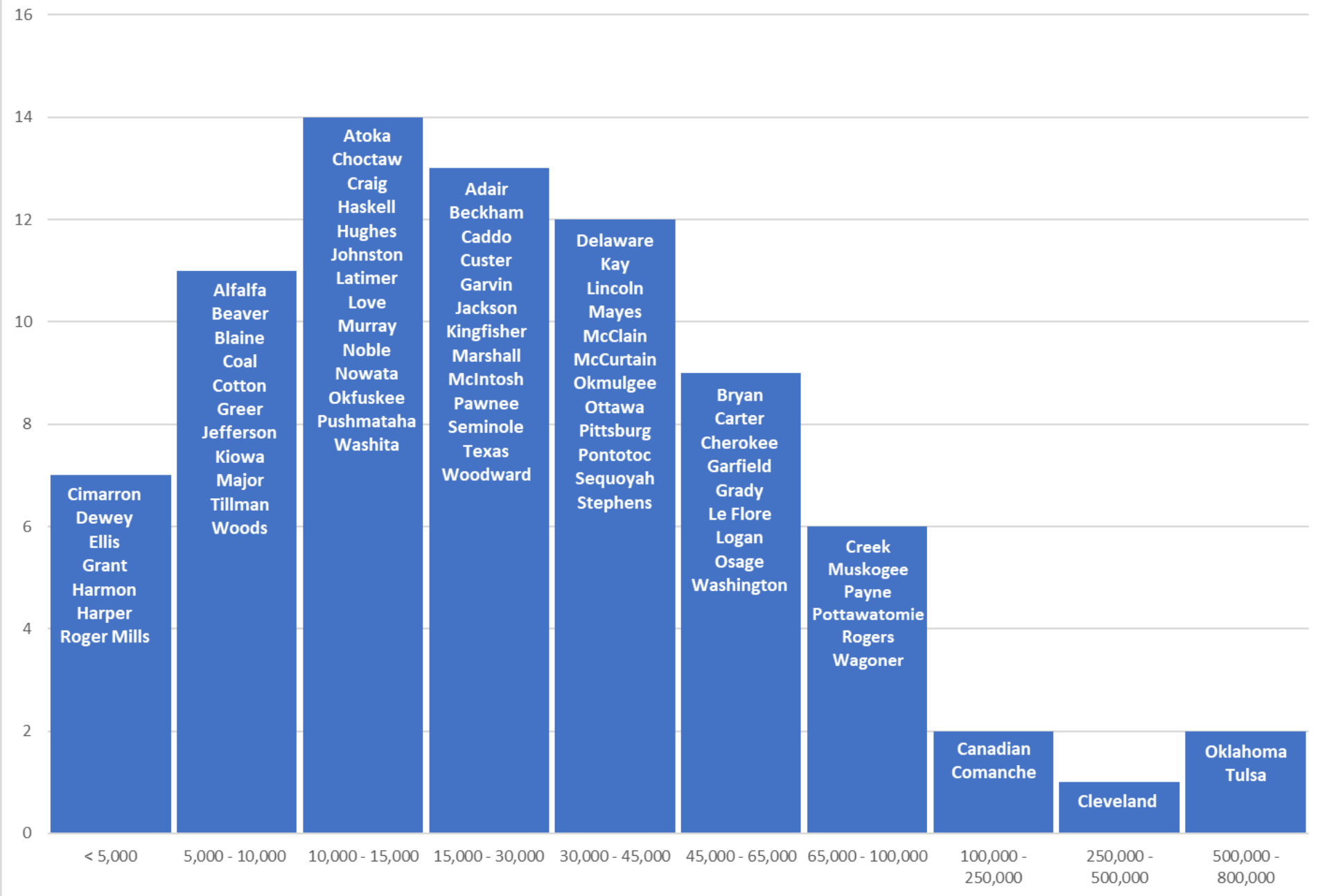
Per Capita Personal Income and Bachelor's or Higher Degrees Population Share



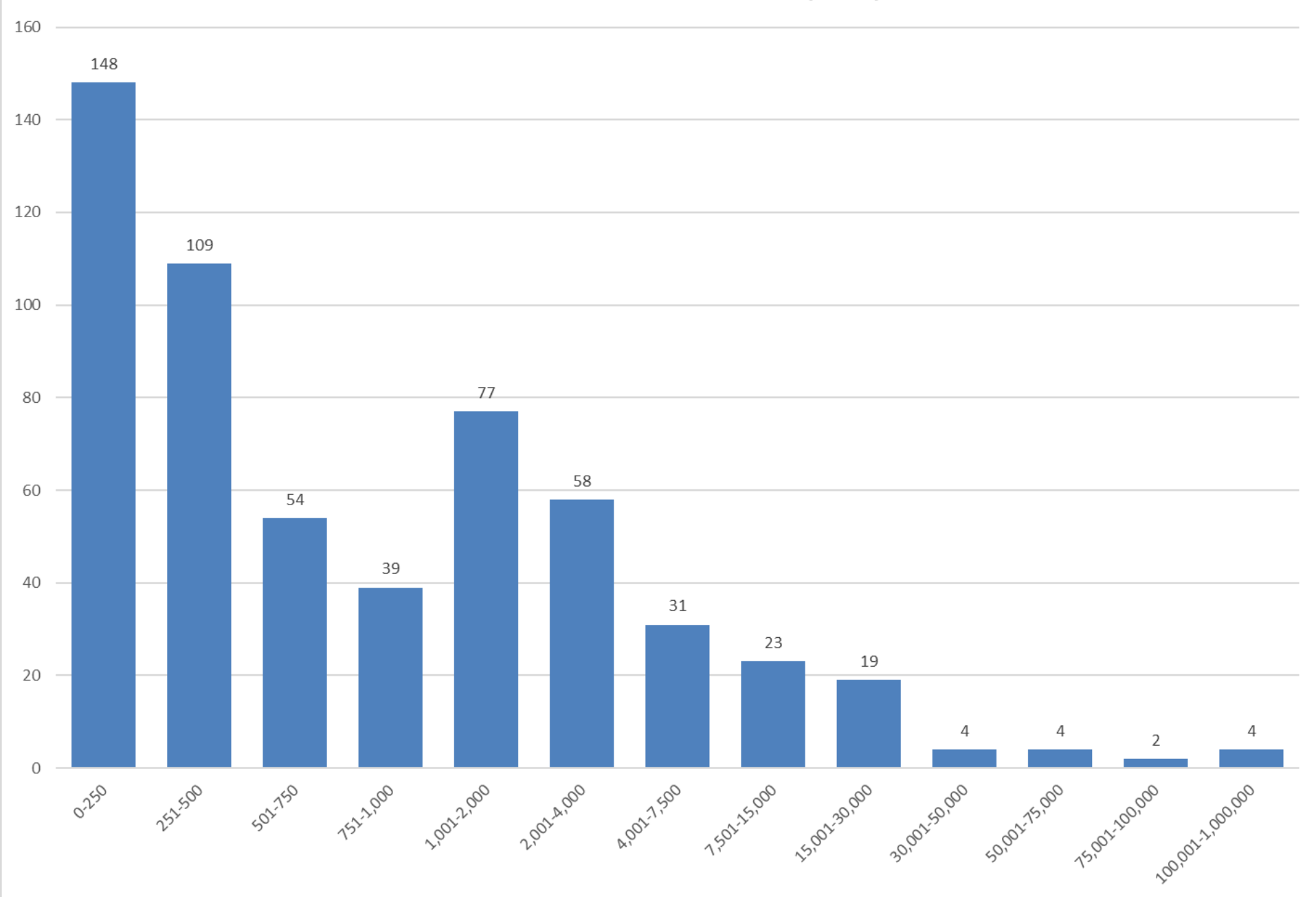
Per Capita Personal Income Distribution for Oklahoma Counties, 2019



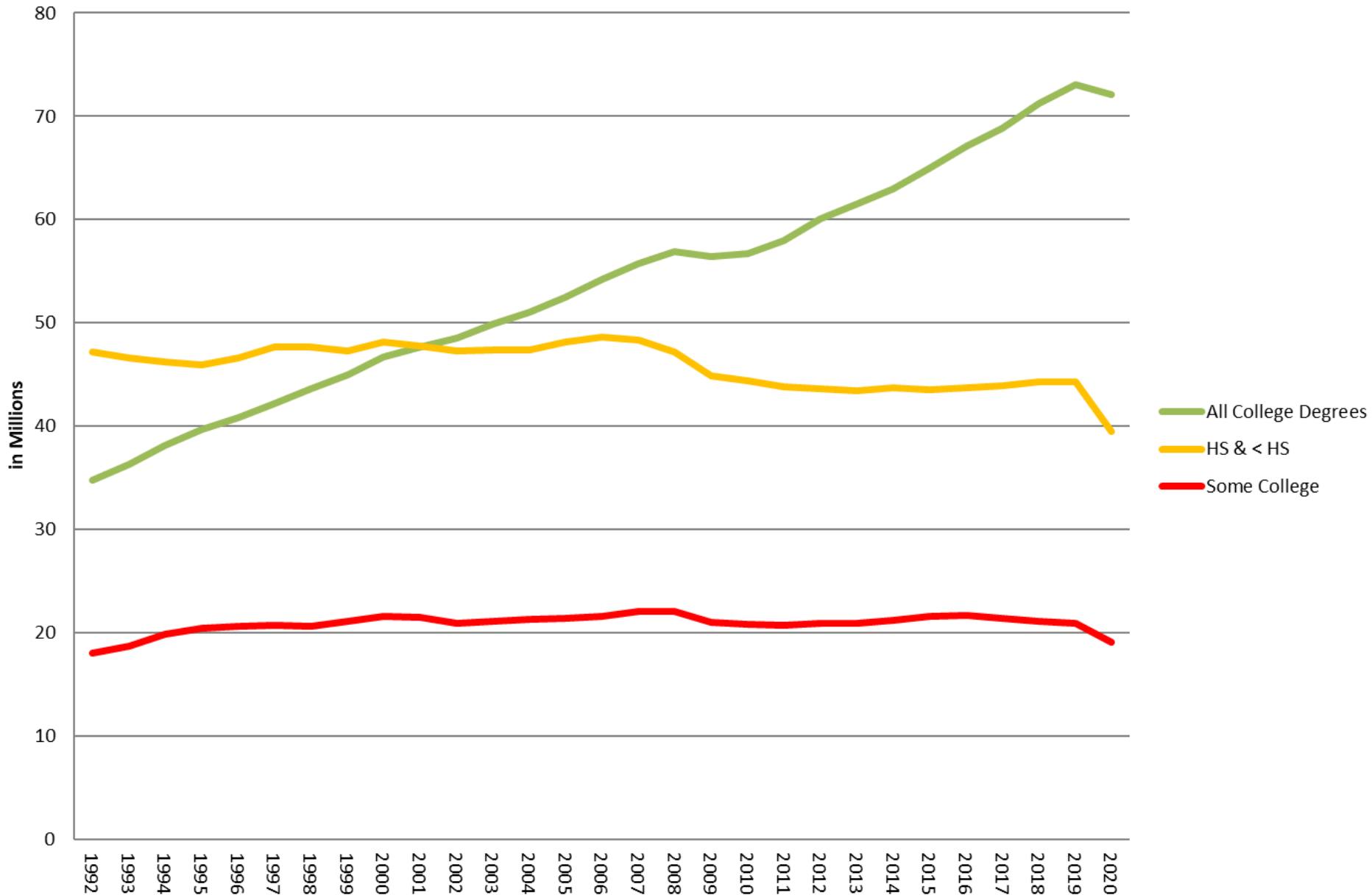
Population Distribution for Oklahoma Counties, 2019
