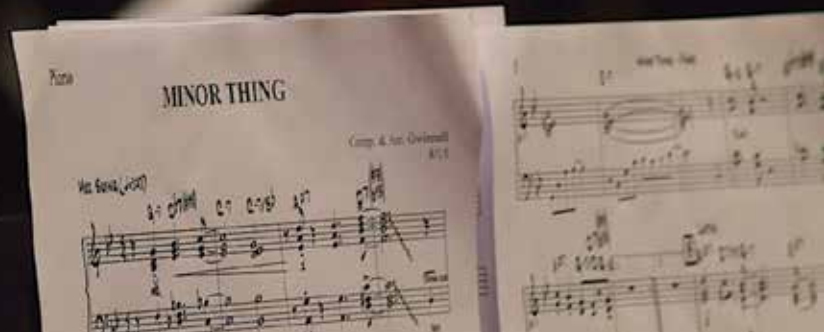

- Our jazz faculty will review the files, and you will be notified by email if you have been chosen for this year's Golden Grizzlies Jazz Camp.
- If you have been accepted, you will be emailed a registration link. Tuition for the Golden Grizzlies Jazz Camp is \$200.
