What's Available This Season

Raw Summer Honey: Pure, raw, and unfiltered. Features a rich golden color with delicious notes of vanilla, light cedar, apple, and subtle floral notes.

Half Pint (12 oz net weight): \$12.00

Pint (22 oz net weight): \$20.00

100% Edible Honeycomb Chunks: Honey in its purest, most untouched form. Hand-cut into 4" x 2.25" slabs straight from the hive. Spread it over warm toast, pair it with sharp cheese on a charcuterie board, or chew it like nature's bubblegum!

1 Box (7 oz): \$7.00

2 Boxes (14 oz): \$13.00

3 Boxes: \$19.00

4 Boxes: \$24.00
