The Opportunity

Reporting to the Vice President for University Advancement, the Director of Advancement Services is responsible for the day-to-day leadership of the Advancement Services area in providing database administration, reporting and information retrieval, gift processing, records management, reporting, analytics, prospect research, software and system support

Responsibilities and Duties

 Supervising database administration, report programming, gift processing, biographical records maintenance, and monitoring progress toward annual, endowment, and capital fundraising goals

- Disseminating routine reports to Development staff
- Developing an annual and longterm operational plan for the use of the database as a strategic tool for the Development Office, including policy and procedure statements to define how the system will be used to support fundraising operations
- Designing and overseeing ongoing staff training program in database and gift administration policies and procedures

Qualifications

A master's degree in a related field and five to seven years of relevant experience are required. Candidate must have a minimum of three to five years of management experience in information, advancement services, development, fundraising, prospect research/management and/or administration for higher education or other non-profit organizations, or equivalent combination of education and experience.





Columbus State University is a comprehensive regional university located 90 miles southwest of Atlanta. The University has a welldiverse student population. It





serves students primarily from the Southeast, while attracting others from 20 nations around the world.

CSU thrives on community partnerships to deliver excellence for students who want to achieve personal and professional success in an increasingly global environment.

The University offers undergraduate and graduate degrees, including a doctorate in education. The College of Letters and Sciences recently launched a Competitive Premedical Studies Program and has proposed a Master of Science in Natural Sciences program with three tracks: Biology, Environmental Science, and Geoscience. The University also provides a variety of online offerings, including full-

degree programs, and an extensive continuing education program.

In 2013, CSU programs in business and education received national ranking by *U.S. News and World Report.* The institution also was ranked in the top 50 of public comprehensive universities in the South.

The University occupies two campuses: one in suburban Columbus, housing programs in the sciences, business, and humanities. The other, called the RiverPark campus, is in the city's historic downtown on the banks of the Chattahoochee River.

RiverPark encompasses about a dozen buildings, including student

The University also offers courses at Fort Benning.

CSU is a Division II member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association. The Cougars field 14 intercollegiate teams.
