

## Tennessee WMU Denver Missions Team

Tennessee WMU will be offering/promoting two mission trip opportunities to Denver this Fall.

### September 15-20, 2022 – TN WMU Denver Prayer Walking Mission Trip

- This is a Tennessee WMU/TBMB sponsored and led team; planning is coordinated with NAMB missionary Dave Howeth. Vickie Anderson, Tennessee WMU Executive Director, will lead this team.
- As part of the TBMB process, team members must fill out a Mission Volunteer Application, a Release Form, and a Health Form. Here is the link to start the process by filling out the application

- Age requirement: 18 years old or older.
- We will hopefully have some Colorado WMU women be part of the team again this year.
- Team member costs will include:
  - Airfare to/from Denver – team members book and pay for their own flights
    - Arrival: arrive in Denver on Thursday, September 15<sup>th</sup> between 10:00 am and 2:00 pm to help coordinate transportation.
    - Departure: schedule a return flight to leave on Tuesday, September 20<sup>th</sup> after 10:00 am to coordinate transportation to the airport.
    - Once you book your flights, please send me your flight information.
  - \$150-200 for transportation in Denver and encourage/ministry activities with missionaries.
    - These funds will be due to Tennessee WMU by the end of August. The exact amount will depend on how many people we have on the team.
    - Tennessee WMU will rent a vehicle(s) in Denver to transport the team.
  - Lodging for five nights, payable in Denver
    - We will reserve rooms at a Drury Inn & Suites. Rooms in the past were \$129 a night plus tax. Team members would decide if they want to share a room with others to share costs or to have a room alone. Drury offers complimentary breakfast and free dinner that the team can take advantage of some nights.
- Meals – travel meals and meals in Denver

### October 15-21, 2022 – Denver Send Relief Mission Trip

- The trip is sponsored, planned, and led by Denver Send Relief. Tennessee WMU/TBMB is promoting and encouraging participation in the trip. Participants would apply through Send Relief website. <https://volunteer.sendrelief.org/Projects/964>.
- Send Relief has 30 spots allocated for this trip, and it looks like two spots have been taken so far.
  - The team could have people from other states.
  - The age requirement is 12 years old or older. Anyone between 12 and 18 must be accompanied by an adult 21 years or older. (Group Ratios 1 adult: 5 students)
- Costs

- Send Relief Fee: \$240 total per person. This cost covers some meals (lunch and dinner) and any programming fees.
  - Team members are responsible for airfare, transportation costs in Denver, lodging expenses (a list of recommended hotels is provided), and some meals.
