The Go Impact prayer walking/vision trip to Berlin was a great learning experience, as several students had not been on a cross-cultural mission trip. They saw people from many nations speaking, heard many different languages, and learned what a completely spiritually lost city looks like. They prayed and talked to people in parks and communities and discovered almost everyone in Berlin is a "none" meaning no religion and no interest. They also saw a large number of Muslims from various nations who live in Berlin. Touring the Berlin wall and seeing the atheism, they saw the power of deception and how failing to teach the next generation about Christ has resulted in a city of total godlessness. The team also got to visit Wittenberg and learn about the Reformation and Luther as one example of a person's influence when they boldly proclaim truth. Pray that as these students process their experience, they will have a greater commitment to sharing the Gospel locally and abroad and pursue missions to the unreached in the future.
