Some of you may have already encountered the new system as many of our schools have begun utilizing it for the 2025-2026 admissions process. Your principal and I are excited about this transition, and we are working closely with each school to ensure full implementation in the 2025-2026 school year.

FACTS was chosen after a thorough review process to replace both TADS and Rediker systems. It will streamline various functions of the school, such as billing, grading, and generating report cards. FACTS handles not only the financial side but also the academic side. This will be more efficient for the school and for families, who will now only need one account to log in and access information, instead of the two currently required. Transitioning to this new student information system will provide more streamlined services to support your child's learning.
