

Dress Code

All students attending WISH Community School (TK-8) are required to follow the WISH dress code. A common dress code promotes equity, focus on learning, positive school culture, and the idea that the mind and body are more important than clothing. Additionally, the dress code supports a safe school environment by helping staff to identify children who are - and are not - part of the school community, both on-campus and on field trips.

Monday-Thursday Dress Code

Pants/Shorts/Skirts Solid blue or beige, denim okay

Dresses/Jumpers Solid blue or beige dress

Tops Solid color white, blue, beige or red shirt

School logo shirt, short or long sleeves, sleeveless,

and wide-band tank tops are acceptable

Shoes Closed-toed, snug fitting shoes, no wheels

Hats No hats of any type are permitted to be worn in class

Friday Free Dress

Clothing containing offensive slogans, symbols and other suggestive or controversial designs or language is not allowed. The following are unacceptable: clothing designed with thin shoulder straps, bare midriffs, halters or bare backs. Shoes must be closed-toed, snug fitting, and may not have wheels. Shorts and skirts must be at least as long as the child's fingertip by his or her side. Socks that fall into these guidelines can be worn any day of the week.
