## STATE OF FLORIDA

## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 23-49

(Emergency Management-Illegal Migration)

**WHEREAS**, on January 6, 2023, I issued Executive Order 23-03, declaring a state of emergency in Florida due to the mass migration of unauthorized aliens to Florida; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 23-03 expires on March 7, 2023, unless extended; and

WHEREAS, an extension of Executive Order 23-03 is necessary because the large influx of migrants remains unabated and the response from the Biden Administration continues to be inadequate; and

WHEREAS, this ongoing crisis continues to strain local resources and requires the continued coordination, direction, and resources of the State of Florida.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS,** as Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Article IV, Section 1 (a) of the Florida Constitution and by the Florida Emergency Management Act, as amended, and all other applicable laws, promulgate the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

<u>Section 1</u>. The state of emergency and all provisions of Executive Order 23-03 are renewed for sixty (60) days following the date of this Executive Order.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 23-03 is ratified and reaffirmed.

## Section 3. This Executive Order is effective immediately.
