Audiences and artists can anticipate the same caliber of high quality fringe art that hails from a wide variety of disciplines. However, in 2025, the festival will be set up in a way that sparks a strong sense of community and connection like never before.

This two day event will feature music, theater, visual art, performance art, dance, story-telling, creative writing, film and more in the heart of Ashland.
