Fellowships provide core financial aid and help us recruit the world's top students. The UC Santa Barbara Fellowship Accelerator Program seeks to raise an additional \$1 million in endowed fellowships this year. Donors will have their gifts amplified: the Graduate Division will take care of the full expected fellowship awards for the first five years. Through this partnership, your support will have a long-lasting impact on generations of graduate students to come.

Program Features

- The Graduate Division will provide the full expected annual fellowship payout from gifts made to new or existing endowments for the first five years.
- The fund principal will grow substantially by reinvesting the investment gains over those five years.
- Fellowship endowments in all academic areas qualify.
- Gifts of \$50,000-\$250,000 qualify for the Fellowship Accelerator. For gifts above that level, the first \$250,000 will be eligible for the Fellowship Accelerator.
- Funds are limited the program will end once the available funds are exhausted.
