

As a child I would copy photos from a grade school primer, later developing into graphite pencil drawing, colored pencil drawing, oil painting, and now, a style of sculpting, oil painting, I have coined, **exsculptainting**: 3-D oil painting on canvas/es, using all sides, sometimes underneath.

The “ex” stands for using bold, bright expressionistic colors; “sculp” is the method of cutting canvas and sculpting them into 3-D forms that are oil painted that becomes a “painting.”
