


DRAW IT







CHILDREN'S WORSHIP • BULLETIN

SOLVE (the) MAZE

In Acts 8, Philip meets a young man who really wants to learn more about Jesus. So Philip tells him about Jesus, and then the young man wants to be baptized right away! Help them find their way to river for Phillip to baptize him!



CONNECT (the) DOTS

Jesus talks about our need for connection with him, and he says, "I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit."
