## 2018 Benchmarking Compliance Deadline Extended

The 2018 Benchmarking compliance deadline for the 2017 calendar year has been extended. The 2017 calendar year data is now due no later than February 15, 2019.

By letter dated January 30, 2019, the Mayor's Office of Long-Term Planning and Sustainability (OLTPS) has advised the Department of Buildings that compliance with Administrative Code §28-309.4 – **Benchmarking Energy and Water Use** - has been temporarily suspended.

Pursuant to Administrative Code §28-309.6, OLTPS has temporarily suspended compliance for calendar year 2017 due to technical issues. The temporary suspension covers calendar year 2017 compliance, which had been due no later than May 1, 2018.

Owners of covered buildings are encouraged to visit the **Benchmarking** section under Sustainability section of the Department's website or check the **OLTPS** page for further details.
