Assoc. Professor of Pediatrics
Div. of Pediatric Hematology/Oncology

Dr. Aristizabal is a pediatric hematologist-oncologist at Rady Children's Hospital - San Diego and a Master of Advanced Studies in Clinical Research at UC San Diego. Her interests include ethics, patient-provider communication and global health, with a focus on discovering the causes of pediatric cancer disparities and developing strategies to improve outcomes in underserved groups.



Debanjan Dhar, PhD
Asst. Professor in Medicine
Div. of Gastroenterology

Dr. Dhar's research focuses on studying liver related diseases such as Hepatocellular Carcinoma, Non-Alcoholic Steatohepatitis and Liver Fibrosis. Dr. Dhar focuses on understanding the basic mechanisms of liver cancer initiation and maintenance with an object of devising new strategies for cancer therapy.



Christina Jamieson, PhD
Assoc. Professor in Residence

Dr. Jamieson's research is focused on elucidating mechanisms of therapy resistance in bone metastatic urologic cancers. She is applying her expertise in genome-wide analysis of prostate cancer tumors and primary patient-derived tumor models to translate next generation genomics on prostate cancers into practical applications and novel therapeutics that will improve and she hopes will transform patient care.
