- Classes meet one Tuesday per month from 5:00-9:00 p.m. with online connections between face-to-face meetings. Classes meet 10/27, 11/3, 12/8, 1/5, 2/9, 3/9, & 4/6. **All classes will meet totally online w/Virtual Sessions on the dates above until it is safe to meet monthly on ground.**
- Face-to-face classes held in the Bloomfield Hills School district at the Doyle Center (7273 Wing Lake Rd, Bloomfield Hills)
- Course content focuses on effective leadership techniques & effective instruction
- Course requirements include an assessment analysis/critique of a building or district initiative or program that connects with each participant's professional role as either teacher or administrator; additional assignments include reviews of current research aligned with school leadership and a comprehensive personal and professional development plan. Assignments are reasonable & connected to your professional & personal development. The course is highly rated by previous participants and provides a safe & healthy forum for professional interaction.
